Cash Blast Promotion Makes Hot Lotto Sizzler Even Hotter!



Buy one ticket, get two chances to win!

Use a nonwinning Hot Lotto Sizzler ticket to enter at ialottery.com Feb. 1 - March 4, 2009

Enter the Hot Lotto Sizzler Cash Blast promotion for a chance to win the top prize of \$100,000 or one of 40 \$500 prizes!

To enter, players should make a Hot Lotto Sizzler ticket purchase of \$4 or more on one ticket. To qualify, tickets must have a minimum of two Hot Lotto Sizzler plays on one ticket. If a player's Hot Lotto Sizzler ticket does not win a prize, they should go to www.ialottery.com to enter the promotion. Players may enter non-winning ticket serial numbers beginning Feb. 1. Eligible nonwinning tickets must have been purchased between Feb. 1 and Feb. 28, 2009. Nonwinning tickets must be entered by noon on March 4. Players must keep all nonwinning lotto tickets they enter and may use each ticket only once as an eligible entry.

One drawing will be held March 4 by the Multi-State Lottery (MUSL). MUSL will draw 40 winners of \$500 from each member state participating in the promotion. One winner of \$100,000 will be drawn from all qualified entries received in all participating states. Players may enter as often as they wish, but may win only one prize.

Entry is online only; no hand-delivered or mail-in entries will be accepted. See the promotional brochure for more details or go to ialottery.com.

How the Hot Lotto Sizzler works . . .

Players should ask for the Hot Lotto Sizzler every time they play Hot Lotto. If they pay \$1 extra per play, they're eligible to triple their Hot Lotto prize, except the jackpot!

Be on the Lookout for VIP Connection Coupons



Be on the alert beginning Feb. 2 for two new coupons from players.

Each quarter, Iowa Lottery VIP Club members receive a "VIP Connection" newsletter. The latest newsletter contains a coupon for \$1 off a \$3 or more purchase of Iowa's \$100,000 Cash Game, either with the number 402 or 403. Both are valid through March 31, 2009. These coupons will vary in appearance. Coupon #402 comes from the color printed copy of the newsletter players receive by mail. Coupon #403 comes via the Internet. Coupon #402 (pictured above) will be in color and about the size of a dollar bill (just a little shorter). Coupon #403 may be larger in size (up to a full sheet) and printed in color or in black and white. It may appear to be a copy — please accept it anyway! **If you have a question about a coupon, please call the nearest lottery office.**

'Mistake' Powerball, Hot Lotto Tickets Can Be Sold

Everybody makes mistakes. Even if your mistake happens to be a Powerball or Hot Lotto play made in error, it doesn't have to be the end of the world!

Think about this: why not sell the ticket? Unless the problem ticket is a mutilated ticket, why not try to sell it to one of your other customers? Especially during busy, high-jackpot times, your customers may be more willing to take that ticket than stand in line. Remember, if you don't follow the steps outlined below, you can't get credit!

Let's review the steps you must take to handle a "mistake" Powerball or Hot Lotto ticket. If the ticket did not print or the ticket is misprinted or mutilated so it can't be validated:

- The defective play must be confirmed by immediately producing a Reprint ticket.
- Call the Scientific Games (SGI) hot line at 800-858-4744. They will provide you with a Control Number. They'll also help you get the information needed to report the problem to the lottery and, if necessary, help you produce the Reprint ticket.
- Any or all parts of the defective ticket, along with the Reprint ticket and Control Number, must be returned to the lottery in the retailer settlement envelope.
- When the lottery receives the defective ticket and the Reprint ticket, we'll examine it and then issue credit to the retailer for the cost of the ticket. You can't receive credit if you don't follow the first three steps!



If the ticket is printed correctly by the terminal, but the clerk or the player makes an error:

- Call the SGI hot line to report the problem and correct ticket information. A Control Number will be provided.
- Remember, the ticket is still valid and can be sold. If you can't sell the ticket, validate it for any prizes won on the ticket after all draws have passed. Then send the ticket and the control number to the lottery in the retailer settlement envelope. The lottery will credit you for the cost of the ticket less any winnings.

The most common reasons for denying credit are: 1) the retailer did not call SGI, and 2) no ticket or play was sent to the lottery. 🚫

Three Iowa Players Win \$10,000 in Midwest Millions Drawing



A Kansas woman won a \$500,000 prize and three of five \$10,000 winners drawn were Iowans in a Jan. 9 joint drawing by the Kansas and Iowa lotteries.

Sandra Vines of Wichita, Kan., was selected as the top-prize winner of \$500,000 in the "Midwest Millions" drawing conducted Jan. 9 by lottery officials at Kansas Lottery headquarters in Topeka, Kan. Five winners of \$10,000 prizes, three of whom were Iowans, also were selected in the drawing. A second drawing in the game is scheduled for April 17 in Iowa.

The Kansas and Iowa lotteries became the first in the United States to offer a joint instant-scratch game when the initial version of Midwest Millions began sales in September 2007. The lotteries are building on that game's success with a second version of Midwest Millions, which is on sale in both states after hitting the market in September.

Players in both states are buying tickets and competing for prizes as part of one big pool.

The idea behind the game is to apply to another product line the "Powerball concept" that has enabled states to join together in lotto games and offer bigger prizes and more chances to win than they would have been able to achieve on their own.

Another drawing offering a top prize of \$500,000 and five prizes of \$10,000 will be held April 17 in Des Moines.

Nearly 70,000 entries were received for the Jan. 9 drawing. Players may enter the Midwest Millions drawings by sending in nonwinning tickets in the game. 🚫
