### ***Policy***

#### **From the WIC Services Policy and Procedure Manual – 390.30 Homeless Facilities**

The following conditions apply to homeless facilities where WIC participants stay:

- The facility must not gain financial or in-kind benefit from a person's participation in WIC.
- WIC foods must not be used in communal feeding.
- No homeless facility restrictions or constraints can exist relative to WIC Program participation. The homeless facility cannot restrict the ability of the WIC participant to get supplemental foods and all associated WIC services made available to participants by the WIC agency.

If an agency has applicants who are using a homeless facility in the agency's service area, contact the facility by phone to verify that the facility meets the conditions above.

### [Consumer Alert - Undeclared Sulfites In Dried Dates](#)

Domega NY International Co. LTD is recalling **Dried Dates** due to the presence of undeclared sulfites. People who have severe sensitivity to sulfites may run the risk of serious or life-threatening reactions if they consume this product.

The recalled Dried Dates are packaged in a 12 oz. (340 gram), plastic bag. There is no apparent production code on the package but a UPC code of 6-868978-724670 can be found on the back of the package. The product was **distributed nationwide** and is a product of China.

### [Andrew Williamson Fresh Produce Announces Precautionary Recall of Organic Grape Tomatoes Due to Possible Health Risk](#)

There is a voluntary **recall of organic grape tomatoes** sold under the **Limited Edition®** and **Fresh & Easy** labels due to a possible health risk from Salmonella. This item was distributed to 18 U.S. states: Arizona, California, Connecticut, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Kansas, Missouri, Montana, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Utah.

## New Formulas in IWIN

PediaSure Peptide 1.5 Cal was added to IWIN this week. This formula is a nutritionally complete peptide-based formula for children with malabsorption, maldigestion and other GI conditions. PediaSure Peptide 1.5 Cal is specifically designed for those children requiring a higher caloric density, have fluid restrictions and are at risk for malnutrition. Checks are written for the 8 fluid ounce container and no more than 12 containers should be placed on a check due to cost.

Glutarex-1 was also added to IWIN this week. This formula is for either infants or toddlers with glutaric aciduria type 1. Glutarex-1 is lysine- and tryptophan-free; contains L-carnitine and taurine; approximately 40% of the energy is from fat; and is lactose and gluten free. Checks are written for the 14.1 ounce (400g) container and no more than 3 cans should be placed on a check due to cost.
