A Waverly man changed his lottery playing habits and as a result, won \$12,000 cash for the upcoming holiday season.

Ed Chesnut, 67, said he usually plays the "Crossword" instant-scratch game. But, he won \$48 the day before on a "Secret Santa" scratch ticket, so he decided to try it again.

"As soon as I scraped it off, I said, 'Holy cow!'" he said. "I looked for the manager right away ... and I had to show him."

Chesnut purchased his winning ticket at Regal Liquor, 121 20<sup>th</sup> Street N.W. in Waverly. He claimed his prize at the Iowa Lottery's regional office in Cedar Rapids.

"It'll go to a good cause somewhere. I don't know if I'll invest it or I might look for another pickup [truck]. I don't know," Chesnut said. He thought his wife might like a computer, too. 🍀

## Three Iowans Win \$100,000 Prizes

Three Iowans claimed \$100,000 Iowa Lottery prizes on the same day.

Leaward Bauers of Altoona, Vicky Epping of Des Moines and Sue Kraus of Mason City each claimed \$100,000 prizes. Bauers won his \$100,000 prize in the Powerball game while Epping and Kraus both won the top prize in Iowa's \$100,000 Cash Game. Each prize was won on a different day, but all were claimed Dec. 1.

Bauers, 50, who works at an office furniture store, said he plans to use his winnings to pay bills and "just have a great Christmas."

Bauers bought his winning ticket at the Git-N-Go Convenience Store at 2221 Adventureland Dr. in Altoona. Bauers' ticket matched the first five numbers but missed the Powerball for a \$100,000 prize. He did not choose the Power Play option, which would have multiplied his prize to \$500,000.

Epping, 35, who works at Target, said she and her husband Doug won their \$100,000 prize in the \$100,000 Cash Game drawing on Thanksgiving Day.

"We're going to have a very nice Christmas, maybe a nice vacation next summer for our family," Vicky Epping said.

Epping bought her winning ticket at the Quik Trip at 2300 E. 14th St. in Des Moines.

A Mason City woman also claimed a \$100,000 prize.

Sue Kraus won the top prize in Iowa's \$100,000 Cash Game on a ticket she bought at the supermarket where she works. Kraus, 53, said she had just gotten off work when she checked her tickets.
