Legal Authority	Code of Iowa, Chapters 17A, 147, 152, and 272C
Job Description	Advanced registered nurse practitioners practice advanced nursing in one of four specialized areas: 1) certified registered nurse anesthetists, 2) certified nurse midwives, 3) certified nurse practitioners, and 4) clinical nurse specialists. Any licensed registered nurse who would like to have prescriptive authority needs to apply for an ARNP license.
Education & Experience Required	Applicants must be licensed as a registered nurse (see Registered Nurse, RN) in Iowa or be recognized for licensure in Iowa by the nurse licensure compact, complete a 12 to 18-month program leading to certification in a specialty area or a 24-month master's degree program, and pass a written national certification examination. Exam dates, fees, and the length of program vary depending on the area of specialization. The RN license is issued for three years, expiring on the 15th day of the birth month of the licensee. Registration as an ARNP is scheduled to coincide with the three-year RN licensure cycle.
Continuing Education	Twenty-four contact hours or 2.4 continuing education units are required for renewal of a license issued for less than three years. Thirty-six contact hours or 3.6 continuing education units are required for renewal of a license issued for three years. Also, evidence of a current certification in a specialized ARNP area will meet this requirement.
Examination	Contact the Iowa Board of Nursing to ascertain which examination, which varies by specialty and sub-specialty, is needed for advanced level certification.
Fees	Application: \$101 – RN license \$164 – both RN and ARNP together Duration: Three years Renewal: \$81 – to renew RN \$63 – ARNP \$144 – both RN and ARNP together Exam: Varies with the certification body
