



# State of Iowa 1998 Inmate Profile

Division of Criminal & Juvenile Justice Planning  
Iowa Department of Human Rights

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## Introduction

This report was compiled at the request of the Department of Corrections. The first section describes Iowa's prison inmate population at mid-year 1998, including:

- Offense type (e.g., arson, assault, burglary, etc.)
- Offense class
- Committing County and Judicial District

The above information is described based on the most serious offense of incarcerated individuals.

Additionally, the following inmate characteristics are summarized:

- Sex
- Race/Ethnicity
- Age (median, or middle value)
- Educational Level (average)
- Reading Scores (average)
- Inmate Custody Scores
- Board of Parole Offender Risk Scores

The first section also provides a comparison of the mid-year 1998 prison population with the population one year ago, and five years ago. Included is analysis of sex, race/ethnicity, age categories, life terms, mandatory minimum sentences, number of sentences per inmate, and offense type.

Following the statewide section are *Facility Profiles* that examine each Department of Corrections institution. The facility profiles cover the same types of information as the statewide report for mid-year 1998, except that committing county and judicial district, Board of Parole risk scores and sex are excluded.

## Data Sources

The information in this report was derived from two sources:

- The E-1 Reports, compiled by the Department of Human Services
- The Adult Corrections Information System (ACIS), compiled by the Division of Criminal and Juvenile Justice Planning (CJJP). *Please note that inmate populations as compiled by CJJP differ from data in the E-1 Reports by a few offenders.* This small discrepancy is likely due to the different times at which the ACIS database was accessed by the respective agencies for reporting purposes.

Data obtained from the E-1 Reports include age, average educational level, and average reading scores. Median custody scores were calculated by CJJP based on information provided in the E-1 Reports. Also, the first two pages of the statewide comparison of inmate characteristics over time were compiled from this source.

Data developed by CJJP from the Adult Corrections Information System focused primarily on descriptions of inmates' most serious offenses. Additionally, committing judicial district and county, Board of Parole risk scores and mid-year 1998 race/ethnicity data (statewide and by facility) were also compiled from this source.

Please note that displayed percentages for various breakdowns (e.g., offense type, offense class, etc.) may not add up to 100% due to rounding.

## **Terms & Definitions**

### *Inmate Custody Scores*

Inmate custody scores are calculated via the Department of Corrections' Inmate Custody Classification System, and are used to determine whether a given inmate should reside in a minimum, medium or maximum security setting. Scores are associated with particular security levels as follows:

<b>Custody Score</b>	<b>Security Level</b>
0-5	Minimum
6-10	Medium
11+	Maximum

### *Board of Parole Risk Scores*

Parole risk scores are calculated via the Board of Parole's offender risk assessment tool, and are used to enhance decision-making when inmates are considered for parole or work release. Risk scores measure the likelihood of re-offense, and are therefore a measure of the potential threat to the public safety posed by a given offender. Risk scores range from one through nine, representing varying degrees of potential threat to the public safety from low to high, respectively.

### *Iowa Offense Classes & Notations*

Iowa offenses are generally classified as felonies or misdemeanors. There are five levels of felonies and three levels of misdemeanors, each carrying one or more distinct maximum penalty.

Felony offense class levels are lettered A through D, with an "other felony" category containing Habitual Offender sentences, a number of drug offenses (e.g., those carrying penalty enhancements) and sexual predators sentenced under Chapter 901A, *Iowa Code*.

Misdemeanor offense classes include aggravated, serious and simple misdemeanors. Misdemeanants may be incarcerated within the state prison system if the total maximum sentence imposed exceeds one year (otherwise offenders must serve their terms in county jails).

The chart and notes on the next page explain the various offense codes used throughout this report:

902.12 Offenders. Offenders committing certain forcible felonies after July 1, 1996 earn much less “good time” than other sentenced offenders do. “BF-85” offenders must serve a minimum of 85% of 25-year terms, with the exception of those sentenced to Murder-2nd degree, who must serve a minimum of 85% of 50-year terms. “CF-85” offenders are serving a minimum of 85% of 10-year terms for Robbery-2nd degree.

901A Offenders. Also after July 1, 1996, certain repeat sex offenders must also serve a minimum of 85% of their maximum terms. “OF-85” offenders are sexual predators sentenced under Chapter 901A, *Iowa Code*. Maximum penalties and time served vary for this group.

OWI Offenders. Felony and misdemeanor drunken drivers are listed separately because most such offenders receive short prison stays prior to being transferred to community-based treatment facilities. This category will include those awaiting transfer to such facilities, as well as those who were returned to prison for failing to abide by the conditions of community supervision.

Violator Program Participants. This group consists of probationers, parolees and work releasees whose community supervision is temporarily suspended for the purpose of participating in the state’s Violator Program. The Violator Program provides a short-term (60-day) incarceration option and treatment for offenders who fail to abide by the conditions of community supervision.

### Offense Types

The various felonies and misdemeanors may be classified according to the type of offense committed, as follows:

- Arson
- Assault (includes Chapter 708 offenses as well as similar offenses in other Code sections, such as child endangerment and tampering with a witness)
- Burglary
- Drug Crimes
- Escape/Flight (includes voluntary absence and failure to appear)
- Forgery/Fraud

- Kidnapping
- Murder/Manslaughter
- OWI/Traffic Offenses
- Prostitution/Pimping
- Robbery (includes extortion)
- Sex Crimes (includes Chapter 709 offenses as well as similar offenses in other Code sections, such as incest and sexual exploitation of minors)
- Theft
- Vandalism
- Weapons Offenses (includes Chapter 724 offenses involving simple possession, rather than use of, weapons)
- Other Offenses (includes conspiracy, solicitation to commit crimes, aiding and abetting, public intoxication, abandonment or neglect of dependent persons, and other offenses not readily classifiable in the above categories)

The above offense types may be grouped within six general categories, as follows:

- Violent: assault, kidnapping, murder/manslaughter, robbery and sex crimes
- Property: arson, burglary, forgery/fraud, theft and vandalism
- Drug: drug offenses
- OWI/Traffic: OWI/traffic offenses
- Weapons: weapons offenses
- Other: escape/flight, other crimes and prostitution/pimping

### Persons/Non-Persons Offenses


Felonies and misdemeanors may also be classified as crimes against persons or not against persons. Crimes against persons are those offenses involving death, injury, attempted injury, abuse, threats, coercion, intimidation or duress. Examples of crimes against persons include all forms of homicide, assault, robbery, terrorism, child endangerment, sex offenses, first degree burglary and first degree arson.

Examples of crimes *not* against persons include burglary and arson offenses other than first degree, drug offenses, forgery, theft and weapons possession (as opposed to use).

### Most Serious Offense

If an offender is incarcerated for more than one offense, the most serious offense is the offense with the longest maximum sentence length. If there are more than one such qualifying offense, then the most serious offense is determined by selecting the crime against persons over the crime not against persons.

## **Selected Highlights**

Examination of the data reveal the following major findings:

- Drug crimes constituted the most common type of offense for which inmates were incarcerated at mid-year 1998, with about 18% of the statewide prison population serving time for this offense. Among female inmates the percentage is higher, with about 25% of the inmate population at the Iowa Correctional Institution for Women serving time for this offense. Drug offenses have comprised an increasing proportion of the inmate population over the past five years (data are based on the most serious offense of incarcerated persons).
- Less than half (42%) of inmates statewide have a most serious offense involving a crime against persons. Among female inmates the percentage is lower, with about 27% of the inmate population at the Iowa Correctional Institution for Women having a most serious offense involving a crime against persons.
- As of mid-year 1998, 480 inmates were serving life sentences. This population has grown by 117 offenders over the past five years.
- Inmates with mandatory minimum sentences to serve have grown at a faster rate than the prison population as a whole. As of mid-year 1998, 1,416 inmates were serving mandatory minimum terms, with 670 added to the population during the past five years.
- While female inmates comprised about 6% of the prison population five years ago, they now make up about 8% of all inmates.
- About 24% of the statewide inmate population is African-American, and this percentage has not substantially changed over the past five years. However, the percentage of Latinos, Native Americans and persons of Asian descent in the prison population *has* increased over the past five years.
- Inmates aged 35 through 60 are a growing proportion of the statewide prison population; while they comprised about one-fourth of all inmates five years ago, they now make up about one-third of all prisoners. Conversely, the age group of 21- through 25-year-olds has proportionately declined over the past five years, although it continues to represent the majority (about 57%) of all inmates. The proportion of inmates aged 20 and younger, or aged 61 and older has remained proportionately the same over the past five years.

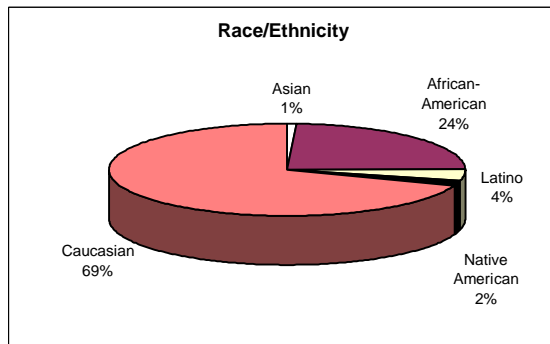
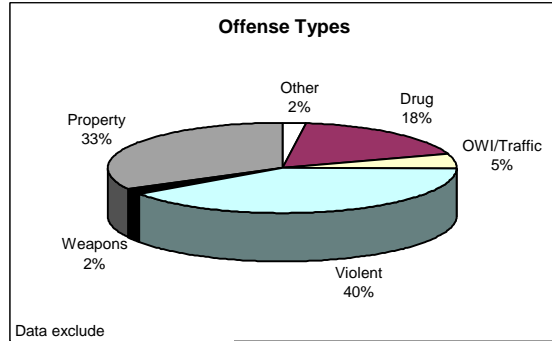
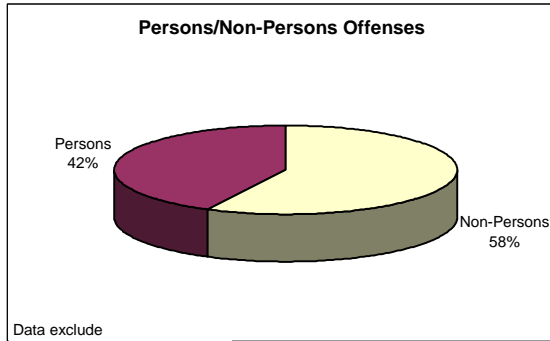
