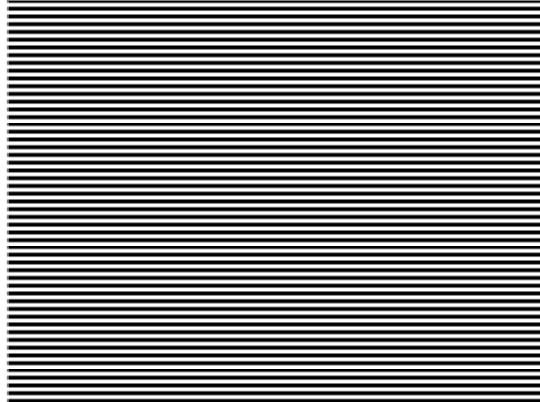

Auditor of State David A. Vaudt today released a report on the Iowa Braille and Sight Saving School, Vinton, Iowa, for the year ended June 30, 2003.

The School is governed by the Board of Regents, State of Iowa and provides residential and day school educational programs for visually impaired youth as well as a variety of resource services for mainstreamed students. For the year ended June 30, 2003, the average enrollment was 37 students with an average cost per student of \$111,241, compared to an average enrollment of 38 students and an average cost per student of \$110,874 for the prior year, as restated to remove capital outlays for construction in progress. During the year ended June 30, 2003, the School provided outreach services to 582 students compared to 594 students in the year ended June 30, 2002.

To the Members of the Board of Regents, State of Iowa:

The Iowa Braille and Sight Saving School is a part of the State of Iowa and, as such, has been included in our audits of the State's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) and the State's Single Audit Report for the year ended June 30, 2003. In addition to these reports, we also prepare a separate report of recommendations pertaining to each School's internal control, compliance with statutory requirements and other matters when our audits disclose findings we believe should be brought to your attention.
