PREFATORY NOTE.

The preparation of this list of Iowa authors grew out of the efforts of the auxiliary committee of the Iowa Commission of the Louisiana Purchase Exposition to bring together a collection of books by Iowa authors for the Iowa State building at the St. Louis Exposition. At the close of the Exposition the books are to be deposited in the State Library to be retained as a separate collection. Not all of the books herein listed are in the exhibit, as some were out of print and for various reasons others could not be obtained.

This committee found it so difficult to trace the literary sons and daughters of Iowa that, having once secured the information, it seemed desirable to put it in printed form.

We have included among Iowa authors those who were born in the State, those who moved into the State when children and became identified with it and those living in the State at the present time and doing literary work. Following the entries of the works of an author, the letter *b* indicates birthplace; *l* indicates that the person lived at place designated. This list, however, is intended to include only those who have written and published books; the magazine and newspaper writers alone would make a long and honored list, as would also the authors of text-books. Inasmuch as all books included were not examined, it is probable that some text-books will be found in the list if they seem adapted to general reading.

A few editors have been included where their work (in their bound magazines) is in permanent form; also, some editors and translators who have added anything to the text edited.

Much valuable material by Iowa writers contained in state and scientific publications could not be included in this list; it was also impossible to include the many valuable law publications.

The list is necessarily incomplete and errors will probably be found; but, faulty as it is, we hope it may be the means of making Iowa authors better known and of stimulating a justifiable

pride in Iowa's creditable standing in the literary world. It is also hoped that the list may prove an aid to the librarians of our State who wish to make a like collection for their libraries.

Numerous lists have been consulted and many and various ways of obtaining the information have been resorted to for the information contained herein, not the least of which was the continued and persistent correspondence with individuals and publishers. Many lists to which we had access give the name of the city in which the book was published and the date, but not the publisher; hence, the lack of uniformity in these entries. *Who's Who in America* has been much used in preparing the list.

For assistance in this work the compiler is under many obligations to Mr. Brigham, State Librarian; Miss Tyler, Secretary of the Library Commission; Mr. Parvin, Librarian Masonic Library, Cedar Rapids; Miss Budington, Librarian State Historical Society of Iowa and the compiler's associates on the auxiliary committee, Mrs. W. H. Baily and Mrs. H. E. Deemer and many others.
