- On site specialized and therapy care in: Dentistry, Optometry, Respiratory Therapy, Podiatry, Audiology, Speech, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Music Therapy.
- Social Workers to partner with the Veterans and families.
- Free transportation to appointments at state VA facilities or other providers.
