## 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE


### Executive Summary

As of 2003, Muscatine County's largest private industry was Manufacturing, representing 34.76 percent (7,614) of the county's total covered employment of 21,907. The county's total employment increased by 0.76 percent since 2002, yet the average annual wage increased by 3.42 percent to \$34,281 for all industries which is 11.2 percent higher than the statewide average.

Muscatine County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$659 for 2003. This was an increase of 3.45 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a sector was Manufacturing, averaging \$884 with gross total wages of \$349.9 million. The Natural Resources & Mining sector had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 28.72 percent (\$108) since 2002.






