In our new for YOU update this week, we are pleased to share information about new early childhood endorsement options that T.E.A.C.H. can support!

- Morningside College Obtain Endorsement 103, PreK-K completely online. Contact Joe Rosener at rosener@morningside.edu for more information.
- University of Northern Iowa Will begin offering Endorsement 100, Birth Grade 3, including special ed, in summer 2015. Courses will be mostly online and will allow for 17-18 credits in approximately 17 months. Contact Gloria Kirkland-Holmes at Gloria.holmes@uni.edu for more information.
- University of Iowa Will begin offering Endorsement 103, PreK-K, in Fall of 2015. Contact Susan Lagos at susan-lagos-lavenz@uiowa.edu for more information.

Office of Child Care (OCC) Announces new CCDF Data Explorer

The Office of Child Care (OCC) is pleased to announce the updated and expanded *CCDF Data Explorer* on the Child Care Technical Assistance Network (CCTAN) Web site (https://childcareta.acf.hhs.gov). The CCDF Data Explorer, which allows users to browse and visualize information from numerous sources, has increased usability features and opportunities for more complex statistical analysis.

The CCDF Data Explorer is now divided into two main areas: "Custom Search" and "Early Care and Education State/Territory Profiles."

- Custom Search allows users to create reports using a wealth of data points on a variety of early
 care and education topics. Reports can contain demographic information, program participation
 and funding, subsidy innovation and program integrity statistics, program quality improvement
 activities, and professional development (PD) and workforce initiatives data.
- The Early Care and Education State/Territory Profiles include commonly requested information about various aspects of child care programs. The data for these profiles include a selection of the most relevant data available via Custom Search.

New Resource for Supporting Homeless Families: Early Childhood Self-Assessment Tool for Family Shelters

The Administration for Children and Families (ACF) recently released a new resource as part of its early childhood (EC) work on the Interagency Workgroup to End Family Homelessness. The Early Childhood Self-Assessment Tool for Family Shelters is designed to help shelter staff create shelter environments that are safe and developmentally appropriate for infants, toddlers, and preschoolers. The tool provides specific recommendations and information on how shelter environments, programming, policies, and staff can support EC safety and child development.

Comments Sought: Caring for Our Children Basics: HHS/ACF Proposed Model Standards

This call for public comment is to obtain information to help HHS further develop the voluntary set of minimum health and safety standards for early care and education settings. Because quality care cannot be achieved without consistent, basic health and safety practices in place, ACF seeks to provide a helpful reference for states and other entities as they work to improve their health and safety standards across program type. Public input will be helpful in providing HHS with practical guidance to aid in the refinement and application of "Caring for Our Children Basics."
