Being able to see the joy and excitement on your faces has made all the hard work over the last year well worth the time and effort. You are all an amazing group of photographers!

NOTHING COMPARES

Each year, I challenge photographers to focus on the art of photography by creating photographs NOT snapshots. The true art of photography is to, "Show us the world as we have never seen it before!" A photograph is so much harder to create than a snapshot. It takes time, thought, creativity, and planning to create. A photograph is actually created in the mind of the photographer well before the shutter is ever released. This book is only possible because of their creativity and vision of the world. Thank You!

We had 1,157 photographers enter the competition this year. Of the 1,157 photographers who entered, 554 (48%) will have at least one photograph on display. Of the 989 adults who entered, 456 (46%) will have at least one photograph on display. Of the 168 youth who entered, 98 (58%) will have at least one photograph on display. For photographers to have even one photograph on display this year is a huge accomplishment. Congratulations!

These very *talented* and *creative* photographers submitted a total of 3,678 photographs. Of the 3,678 photographs entered, 862 (23%) were selected for display. Of the 3,230 photographs submitted by *adults*, 729 (23%) were selected for display. Of the 448 photographs submitted by *youth*, 133 (30%) were selected for display. Only *four* photographers, three adults and one youth, will have *all four* photographs on display this year.

I cannot begin to thank our Judges enough for their time and effort. We ended up doing 13 rounds of judging this year. The judges looked at every photo that was entered at least three different times. They also looked at every photo that made it in the show' at least twice for a possible award. Their thoughtful consideration of every photo that was entered has resulted in a fantastic display.

Nothing Compares to my dedicated staff and a host of volunteers. It would be impossible to do this each year without their help. I would also like to thank the lowa State Fair Entry Department and the summer interns who process the entry forms for every competitive event at the fair. They processed more than 16,500 entry forms and almost 60,000 entries this year. One person who will be greatly missed but never forgotten is Art Berven. He was a kind and gentle soul that touched us all.

I would like to personally thank our sponsors and advertisers for their contributions. Many of our awards simply would not be possible without our sponsors. This book would also not be possible without the support of our advertisers. The staff at University Photo deserves special recognition for donating their time to scan and edit each of the award winning photos in this book.

Happiness Is also seeing the 181 incredible award winning photos inside this year's book. Enjoy!

#### **HOW TO ENTER**

Entry Rules and Entry Forms will be available online at www.iowastatefair.org by April 1, 2014. Read next year's Entry Form carefully. There may be additional changes in the entry rules and deadlines.

#### **ENTRY RULES**

- 1. PHOTOS: For 2014 only, all photos must be in Black & White.
- 2. JURIED COMPETITION: Only those photos selected by the panel of judges will be exhibited.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY: Photos previously exhibited at the lowa State Fair are NOT eligible for entry.
- ORIGINALITY: Photographers must use their own ideas and concepts when creating their photos.
   Do NOT copy or duplicate the ideas of other photographers or previous winners.
- 5. ENTRIES: Each photographer can enter up to five photos. There is a limit of one photo per class.
- 6. CLASSES: Classes are determined by the main subject matter of each photo. The same photo or similar photo CANNOT be entered in multiple classes. To increase your chances of being exhibited, your photos should be of entirely different subjects.
- 7. PHOTO BACKING: All photos <u>must</u> be mounted on 11" × 14" foam core that is at least 1/8" thick. Exception: Photos in the Panoramic class <u>must</u> be mounted on 7" × 20" foam core that is at least 1/8" thick. Do NOT use mat board or styrene. (NOTE: Due to the heat and humidity, it is highly recommended that photos be dry mounted. Available at most art supply stores and frame shops.)
- 8. PHOTO SIZE: Photos can be any size up to and including 11" × 14". However, note Entry Rule #7.
- 9. MATS: We judge your photo NOT the mat. Mat colors should NOT compete with your photo.
- 10. TITLES: We judge your photo NOT the title. Please limit titles to three or four words.
- 11. ENTRY: Your name, photo title, date of photo, and other text must NOT appear on front of entry.
- 12. PRESENTATION: All photos must be unframed. There should be NO hooks or wires attached to the back of entries. Do NOT cover entry with cellophane, acetate, or glass. There should be NO spray adhesive or self-stick adhesive exposed that could damage another person's photo.
- 13. REPRODUCTION: lowa State Fair reserves the right to reproduce in any form any work submitted.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE: All photos will be handled with care. However, the lowa State Fair is NOT responsible for any loss or damage to entries.

NOTE: Any photo that does NOT meet the above requirements will NOT be judged. Entry fees will NOT be refunded.

ENTRY BY MAIL: Do NOT mail <u>before</u> Monday, May 19. Entries by mail <u>must</u> be postmarked by <u>midnight</u> on Saturday, June 7. #### SUPERINTENDENT'S COMMENTS

To be successful you must take the *time* and *effort* to shoot for the lowa State Fair Photography Salon. Do NOT pull photos *off the computer* at the very *last* minute. Spend a day, week, or month *shooting* for *just* one class. Also, keep in mind that the lowa State Fair Photography Salon is about the *art* of Photography NOT Photoshop. Your *goal* is to, "Show *us* the *world* as *we* have *never* seen *it* before!" How *you* accomplish *this* is the *art* of photography.

#### **COMMON MISTAKES**

- 1. Do NOT copy or duplicate photos in the Salon Book and ideas of other photographers or previous award winners. Photographers must use their own ideas and concepts when creating their photos.
- Do NOT keep taking photos of the same old landmarks. For example: The judges have seen photos
  of every bridge across the interstate, the Des Moines River, the High Trestle Trail, and Gray's Lake.
- 3. The color of the mat on your photo should NOT compete with your photo. The judges CANNOT see your photo for all the hot pinks, reds, oranges, yellows, purple, and velvet mats. Keep it simple!
- 4. It is NOT the judges' responsibility to pick out your best baby, dog, cat, bird, frog, preying mantis, locust, jellyfish, butterfly, flower, people, building, or landscape photo. Submit four unique subjects!

#### TIPS FOR ENTERING

- Composition! Composition!
- The judges are looking for photographs NOT snapshots!
- The judges do NOT like to see photographs that are too staged or set up.
- Change your angle of view. See the world from a different viewpoint. Get off your feet!
- Change your lens. See the world from a different perspective. Take off your favorite lens!
- Get closer. Crop tighter. Crop with your lens! Image quality is lost if you always crop in Photoshop.
- Learn the Rule of Thirds. Do NOT put your subject in the center!
- Is your main subject in focus? If it is out of focus, it is out of the show.
- What is your main subject? If the judges CANNOT tell, it is out of the show.
- Watch for background distractions. Look carefully around your main subject before taking your photo.
- Do NOT always have your main subject (people, dogs, cats, etc.) stare directly into the camera.
- Do NOT copy or duplicate the ideas of other photographers or previous winners.
- · Do NOT submit photos that are similar in nature. Enter photos with different subject matters.
- Do NOT keep entering the same classes every year. Challenge yourself!
- Give yourself assignments. Spend a day, a week, or a month shooting for just one class.
- If your horizon is NOT level, it is NOT in the show. Buy a grid screen or use the feature on your camera.
- Buy a vertical grip or rotate your camera to fit your subject. Do NOT suffer from horizontal's disease!
- Do NOT over-sharpen your images!
- Do NOT over-saturate your images!
- Color calibrate your monitor at least once a month.
- Black & White photos should be Black & White NOT Black & Blue!
- Use a good photo lab or make sure you have a high quality home printer. Print quality is everything!
- Using the smallest JPG setting means you will get more photos on your card and less photos in the fair.
- Judges cannot judge what they cannot see. I recommend that photos be at least 8" × 10" or larger.
- Learn how to see light. Photography is all about the light!
- Learn about film speeds, shutter speeds, and apertures.
- Learn how to control your depth of field by changing your aperture.
- · Learn how to operate your camera. Read the owner's manual!
- Run film/pixels through your camera. The more you shoot the better you will get!
- Take a class or join a local camera club!

#### 75th ANNUAL PHOTOGRAPHY SALON – SALUTE TO ANSEL ADAMS 2014 THEME CLASS: MY ANSEL ADAMS

"Twelve significant photographs in any one year is a good crop." - Ansel Adams

Nothing Compares to next year's challenge. For one year only and in celebration of the 75<sup>th</sup> Annual lowa State Fair Photography Salon, all photos that are entered <u>must</u> be in Black & White. Photographers can also submit five photos for one year only. Next year's exhibit will not only be a celebration of the history of photography at the lowa State Fair, it will also be a salute to one of the world's most famous photographers - Ansel Adams.

The 2014 theme class is called My Ansel Adams for a reason. Next year's theme is about the Ansel Adams that lives inside you. We want to see what it is that inspires you about photography. What is it that drives you outside an hour before sunrise and keeps you outside until at least an hour after sunset?

The photo you enter in the theme class should be what you consider to be some of the best work of your life. It might be a photo you took ten years ago or the one that you have yet to take. The subject matter is up to you. Again, we want to see what inspires you. Looking for inspiration or have never heard of Ansel Adams, I highly recommend watching the PBS video that documents his life.

NOTE: Do NOT in anyway try to copy, duplicate, or replicate the work of Ansel Adams.

Next year's divisions are: Adult Division: Black & White (Digital), Adult Division: Black & White (Film), Youth Division: Black & White (Digital or Film), and Special Division: Black & White (Digital or Film). Black & White film is alive and well so dust off the old film camera and clean up the old darkroom.

Never taken Black & White photos before, there are tons of resources on the internet. My advice is to change the settings inside your camera to Monochrome so that you can start to see in Black & White. Spend a day, a week, a month, or the entire year shooting in just Black & White. By doing so, you will begin to focus more on composition, lighting, textures, and the tonal range of the scene. Learn about the Zone System that Ansel Adams and Fred Archer developed. Also, try changing the contrast and sharpness settings inside your camera. Experiment with the red, yellow, orange, and green filters built into your camera. You do NOT have to be a Photoshop or software expert to get some really great Black & White photos coming directly out of your camera.

Our challenge, including me, over the next year is to become better photographers and even better story tellers. It's about remembering the joy, passion, excitement, and inspiration behind our very first photographs. What is it about photography that still excites and inspires you to this very day?

Also remember to focus on the art of photography by creating photographs NOT snapshots.

A photograph is so much harder to create than a snapshot. It takes time, thought, creativity, and planning to create. A photograph is actually created in the mind of the photographer well before the shutter is ever released. The true art of photography is to, "Show us the world as we have never seen it before!"

The number in **parentheses** indicates the number of **photos** that each Adult Exhibitor has on display. The number of **asterisks** indicates the number of **awards** they received. Names that are **bolded** received the **Superintendent's Merit Award for Photographic Excellence** for having **all four** of their photos accepted for display. Of the 1,157 photographers who entered, only 4 (.3%) photographers (three adults and one youth) received this award.











