# OLDER Lowans:2018

**MAY 2018** 

A meeting with the National Council of Senior Citizens resulted in President John F. Kennedy designating May 1963 as Senior Citizens Month, encouraging the nation to pay tribute in some way to older people across the country. In 1980, President Jimmy Carter's proclamation changed the name to Older Americans Month, a time to celebrate those 65 and older through ceremonies, events and public recognition.

#### 514,215

The estimated number of people age 65 and over in lowa in 2016. This age group accounted for 16.4 percent of the total population. In 2016 lowa ranked 16th in the percentage of population age 65 and older.

#### 285,825

The estimated number of women age 65 and over in lowa in 2016. This accounted for 55.6 percent of the age group 65 and over. The estimated number of women age 85 and was 52,355. This was 66.5 percent of lowans 85 and over.

#### 677,266

The projected population age 65 and older in lowa in the year 2050. According to Woods & Poole Economics Inc., this age group will constitute 19.7 percent of the states's total population at that time.

Percent of lowans age 65 and over who lived alone in 2016.

#### 16,681

The number of children under 18 who are being cared for by a grandparent in lowa in 2016.

#### 24,418

Number of Iowans age 65 and older in 2015 who lived in group quarters. Group quarters include nursing facilities; military quarters, correctional facilities as well as college student housing. This age group is 24.3% of the total group quarter population.




## **Education**




