DES MOINES – The DNR Air Quality Bureau has the following draft permits up for review. The permits help protect Iowans' health and the air where we live. DNR's permitting staff review the applications to ensure facilities comply with state and federal air quality standards. The public has the right and is encouraged to comment on draft permits. DNR considers [public comments](#) before finalizing the permits. Submit comments in writing to the assigned permit writer before 4:30 p.m. on the last day of the public comment period.

Title V Operating Permits

Title V Operating permits are reviewed and re-issued every five years. Facilities with a Title V permit have the potential to emit large amounts of air pollutants compared to other facilities. The five-year reviews are a federal requirement and ensure adequate monitoring is included in the permit. The DNR plans to issue Title V Operating Permits for the following facilities. Black Hawk County Cedar Falls Municipal Electric Utility - CTS – 2506 W. 27th St., Cedar Falls. The application was submitted to operate their existing Electric Services facility. The public comment period ends July 6.

Black Hawk County University of Northern Iowa – Main Campus – 1801 W. 31st St., Cedar Falls. The application was submitted to operate their existing university facility. The public comment period ends July 6.
