New Fact Sheet Provides Assistance on Indoor Venting Sources

The DNR has developed a fact sheet to assist applicants with determining when a facility should consider using the small unit exemption or applying for an air construction permit to restrict potential emissions from indoor venting sources. The information presented in the fact sheet titled "Indoor Venting Sources" provides assistance to facilities on evaluating potential to emit for indoor venting sources.

Based on comments and questions received from industry, DNR, and other stakeholders during the review period, the DNR revised the fact sheet.
