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#### **Budget Targets**

Budget targets are created by legislative majority leadership in each chamber. They provide direction to each of the appropriations committees' budget chairs on how much funding they can appropriate to executive branch departments under their purview. For IDPH, that is the <a href="Health and Human Services">Health and Human Services</a> (HHS) <a href="Budget Subcommittee">Budget Subcommittee</a>.

Here are the FY 2019 targets for each chamber and the Governor's Recommendation:
