Auditor of State Rob Sand today released a report on the University of Northern Iowa, Cedar Falls, Iowa for the year ended June 30, 2019. The University of Northern Iowa previously released its annual financial report for the year ended June 30, 2019.

The University of Northern Iowa is governed by the Board of Regents. For the year ended June 30, 2019, the full-time equivalent student enrollment was 9,201 with an average cost per student of \$15,940, compared to 9,535 students and an average cost per student of \$15,145 for the year ended June 30, 2018.

AUDIT FINDINGS:

Consistent with the prior year, Sand reported no findings related to the receipt and expenditure of taxpayer funds.

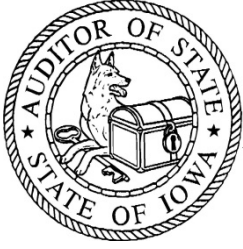

To the Members of the Board of Regents, State of Iowa:


