## LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

---

*To His Excellency, B. F. CARROLL, Governor of Iowa:*

DEAR SIR—In accordance with the provisions of section 2509-a of the supplement to the code, I have the honor to transmit herewith a report of the inspections made by the oil inspectors of the state, including the receipts and expenditures, during the biennial period ending June 30, 1910.

It is a pleasure to report that the increase in net receipts to the state noted in my report of two years ago has not only been maintained, but has received material addition during the past biennial period. The increase in the use of petroleum products has been so great in the last few years, that the state has been materially benefited financially in the inspection thereof.

During the past two years 723,614 barrels of oil have been inspected, and 584,779 barrels of gasoline passed, for which the state, after deducting rebates for oil shipped out of the state, received \$129,520.06. The cost of the inspection service during the same period was \$51,868.62, leaving the state as net receipts, \$77,651.44. Of the amount received for inspection, 59.95 per cent was profit to the state, and 40.05 per cent represents the cost of inspection; this is a gain of 6.74 per cent in net receipts over the preceding period. The cost of inspection per barrel is steadily decreasing, due to the fact that the increased quantity inspected has not required a proportionate increase of expense.

The net receipts of the state for the period ending June 30, 1910, are \$32,850.58 greater than for the period ending June 30, 1906, while the expenses of inspection for the period ending June 30, 1910, are \$5,025.07 less than for the period ending June 30, 1906.

All of which shows that the inspection service is in a healthy condition; that it has been carefully supervised by the clerk in charge of that service in this department, and that the inspectors have performed their duties with care and thoroughness, and merit the cordial commendation due to honest and faithful servants of the people.

In submitting this report, I desire to respectfully suggest that the law in reference to the inspection of petroleum products might be made clearer and materially strengthened, by brief amendments. There have been several occasions where a controversy has arisen between this department and one of the larger corporations, in which it was claimed by the latter that the petroleum products used by it need not be inspected by the state; that inspection by its own inspectors was a sufficient safeguard. The contrary was held by this department, and finally in each case the controversy was concluded by the corporation deciding to comply with the requirements of this department. This yielding by the corporation may have been as a matter of policy, rather than a confession that its interpretation of the law was wrong. It seems to me the law should state in plain language that all petroleum products to be used within the state must be properly inspected by a state inspector.

The law in regard to the sale and use of gasoline seems to be lacking in sufficient provision for its enforcement. The law requires that cans or other receptacles for holding gasoline shall be painted a vermillion red, and have the word "Gasoline" stencilled or marked thereon. I am advised that in some instances the paint and lettering on the cans, that at one time were made to comply with the law, have been worn off so that it is difficult to tell whether they were ever painted and lettered, or not. It seems to me the state oil inspectors should be authorized and required to file complaints with the proper authorities in all such cases they may discover, or that may be brought to their attention. This law is for the safeguarding of human lives and the protection of property and when not fully complied with voluntarily should be properly enforced.
