<u>Operator Certification: Continuing Education Opportunities</u>



Beginning July 1, 2021, the SRF staff will no longer be pulling the Davis-Bacon wage determinations for SRF projects. That process will now be completed by someone working directly on the project (consulting engineer, city staff, individual responsible for Davis Bacon compliance, etc.). If an additional job classification is needed, the Form SF 1444 ("Request for Authorization of Additional Classification and Rate") must still be sent to Iowa Finance Authority (IFA) to submit to the Department of Labor (DOL).

Note that this change applies ONLY to projects funded solely with SRF. If the project is funded with CDBG and SRF, continue to use the CDBG Davis-Bacon process.
