Powerball Changes Spread Winnings

Changes to the Powerball game are designed to create larger jackpots and spread big winnings among more players.

New features took effect in the game Oct. 6, as Powerball tickets went on sale in South Carolina, the 24th lottery to join the game.

The traditional design of Powerball, with players choosing numbers from two separate pools of numbers, remains the same. But four numbers have been added to the first pool, which has had 49 numbers in it. Players now pick five numbers out of a pool of 53 for the first five numbers in the game and another number—the Powerball—from a pool of 42. Be sure to remind players to use the new play slips because the old ones are no longer valid.

Iowa Lottery Commissioner Ed Stanek said that as Powerball's player base has expanded, lotteries in the game have needed to ensure that it will continue to offer what customers want: large jackpots. And, the changes mean that in some instances the big winnings will spill down, another frequent request.

Match 5 Bonus Pool Divided With Jackpot Win

A new "Match 5 Bonus" system will take effect when the Powerball jackpot reaches a new record level (the current record of \$295.7 million was set in July 1998). Once in new territory, the jackpot will grow by no more than \$25 million between drawings until it is won. Prize money beyond that will go into a separate "bonus pool." When the jackpot is won, the bonus pool money will be divided among players who win Powerball's second prize of \$100,000 by matching the first five numbers but not the Powerball. In some cases, the match-five prizes may each end up being \$1 million or more.

Power Play at Least Doubles Prizes

Another important change has come in the Power Play option. Under the new system, prizes won with the Power Play are at least doubled. *The "1"s are gone!*

Coupon Redemption Period Changes

Recently the Iowa Lottery changed its policy on when coupons are due in the Weekly Settlement Envelope. When a coupon expires, it must be returned in the Weekly Settlement Envelope for the week it expired or in either of weekly settlement envelopes for the next **two weeks**.

New VIP Coupon in Circulation Now

Be on the lookout for a new player coupon from the "VIP Connection" newsletter. Coupon #174 entitles the player to \$1 off their total purchase when they buy \$5 or more of Hot Lotto on one ticket. Enter the proper play for the player and then process the coupon using the three-digit coupon number. Look inside this newsletter for a review of the coupon procedure.

Players add the Power Play to their Powerball purchase for an extra \$1 per play. A Power Play wheel is spun during the Powerball drawings. Slots on the wheel formerly listed the numbers 1 through 5, indicating the amount prizes (except the jackpot) will be multiplied if that number is drawn. Now that the "1" has been removed, player are guaranteed that Power Play prizes will at least be doubled.

The final change adjusts the annuity option for the Powerball jackpot. Jackpot winners formerly could choose to receive the prize as a lumpsum cash payment or in 25 annual payments. Now, the annuity option is 30 annual payments.

Retailers have new brochures for players detailing all the Powerball changes.

Stanek said the overall chance of winning a cash prize in Powerball will change only slightly, from about 1 in 35 to 1 in 36. The odds of winning the jackpot will change from about 1:80.1 million to 1:120.5 million.

can purchase the Venetian® Las Vegas scratch ticket to qualify starting Oct. 14.


This ticket has four play areas. In the "Slots" play area, if a player matches three like symbols per spin, they win the prize shown. In the "Bonus Spot" area, if the player finds a prize amount, they win that prize instantly. In the two "Blackjack" play areas, if "Your Hand" beats the "Dealer Hand," the player wins the prize for that hand.

If the prize won is a "TV Drawing" symbol, the player should complete the name and address section on the back of the ticket, add a first class

postage stamp and mail the ticket. The ticket is now a self-mailer. Players no longer need to use the green "Powerball Game Show" envelope to

send in the entry.

Processing Coupons Easy With Procedure

Getting proper credit for coupons isn't difficult if you follow the proper procedure.

- Coupon entry must be done **before** the customer is closed out and within 10 transactions of the play the coupon was good for.
- The computer system will check to make sure the tight type of play was made.

• Put all coupons in the Weekly Settlement Envelope.

To enter a coupon on the Extrema:

- 1. Make the play the customer has requested. Touch "Coupon" on the main screen.
- 2. Enter the three-digit coupon number on the keypad. Touch "OK."

3. The terminal will issue credit for the coupon amount.

To enter a coupon on the Sci-Scan:

- 1. Make the play the customer has requested.
- 2. Select Option 3 from the main display. Enter the three-digit coupon number.
- 3. The terminal will issue credit for the amount.

A year after he lost his home to fire, a Boone man has won a \$50,000 lottery prize.

"The house we used to live in burned down a year ago," Mike Stumbo said. "We're sort of under the theory that we deserve this."

Stumbo, 44, who works for a documents company, claimed the top prize of \$50,000 in Red Hot 7s.

Stumbo said his lottery win continued a week of good news for him. It started earlier in the week when he found out he'd won \$33 in an office football pool.

"This is a little bit more," he said. "You add a few zeros on."

Stumbo bought his winning ticket at Hy-Vee at 1111 Eighth St. in Boone. He said he'll use his winnings to pay some bills and make Christmas a little bigger than normal for his wife and children.
