REPORT OF THE TREASURER OF STATE.

To His Excellency, HORACE BOIES, Governor of Iowa:

SIR—As required by Section 2, Chapter 175, of the Nineteenth General Assembly, I have the honor to submit herewith the following report of this office for the biennial period ending June 30, 1893. In submitting this report I deem it proper to furnish a few facts and figures for your own information and for the consideration of the members of the Twenty-fifth General Assembly. This report shows receipts from all sources and disbursements for the biennial period; also the condition of the treasury at the close of business, June 30, 1893.

The latter showing, while true, is in a sense misleading, because at that time we had received the major portion of the spring collections of general revenue and consequently our balances were larger than at any other period in the year, while one day later (July 1) the State's matured obligations to its public institutions and other sources amounted to almost \$300,000.

This is true to a greater or lesser extent with all our settlements. For example, on January 1, 1893, we had on hand \$215,527.70, including the \$150,000 soldiers' monument fund provided for by the Twenty-fourth General Assembly, while nineteen days later, had it not been for the \$150,000 monument fund on hand, State warrants to the amount of \$64,515.60 would have been stamped "not paid for want of funds." Fortunately taxes from insurance companies, telegraph and telephone companies began coming in about this time and relieved us from that humiliating ordeal.

The quarterly payments due July 1, 1893, October 1, 1893, and January 1, 1894, will probably reduce our present balance and the amount received from October collections so as to render the first payment of salary to the Twenty-fifth General Assembly when due, extremely doubtful; and unless the legislature so amends the law that quarterly payments to State institutions will fall due thirty days later than now, there will not be sufficient revenue on hand April 1, 1894, to pay their warrants when presented.

Under the old law taxes were payable and due at the capitol before the State's obligations matured, but when the change was made from annual

to semi-annual payments, the time for paying taxes was extended thirty days without providing that the State's obligations should be correspondingly extended.

Should the quarterly payments be made thirty days later we can hope to pay the General Assembly its last half at the close of its session; otherwise it probably cannot be done until near the first of May. No doubt this will surprise those persons who have no other means of acquiring a knowledge of the facts except as read in the newspaper reports of the quarterly settlements made by yourself and the Auditor of State; these settlements as directed by law are generally made when the treasury is at its best, and while true as to fact, are deceptive because they do not present to the public the State's obligations then due. Again, the Twenty-second and Twenty-third General Assemblies reduced the State levy a half mill, which caused a loss in revenue received from counties during the last biennial period of \$291,200.22.

This loss was partially reimbursed by the increased payments of insurance companies in the sum of \$49,692.20; fees from State officers, \$16,796.33; from miscellaneous sources, \$29,795.68; from telegraph and telephone companies, \$724.13, making an increase from these sources of \$97,008.34, or a net loss from all sources of \$194,191.88 for the biennial period.

The increase in real estate assessment in the State for 1893 and 1894 will, in my opinion, add to the gross amount of revenue sufficient to meet the demands of the increased current expenses and no more, and I would suggest to your excellency that recommendations be made to the Twenty-fifth General Assembly as follows: *First*, amend the law so that payments to the State institutions will be payable thirty days later than now; *second*, that the $\frac{1}{2}$ mill levy be again restored, unless the law is so amended as to make full value assessments in fact; *third*, that no appropriations be made in anticipation of the increased levy until the Twenty-sixth General Assembly meets.

All the increase that will be realized in the collections of 1895 will be needed to clear up the then outstanding warrants unless appropriations for State institutions already in operation are lower than in the past, and that I regard as a very poor kind of economy. Our State is rich, our people have a just pride in knowing we are out of debt and have such good and commodious public institutions for educational, charitable and humane purposes. I believe, I know that we much prefer the small increase in the levy to the humiliating fact that our warrants are not paid when presented.
