Denison Man Claims \$2.7 Million Jackpot

A Denison man got a dose of holiday cheer, claiming a \$2.7 million Hot Lotto jackpot he won on Christmas Day.

"A guy thinks about it. You buy a ticket and you have in the back of your

mind, 'There's that chance,'" Don Sporrer said as he claimed the jackpot at Iowa Lottery headquarters in Des Moines.

Sporrer, 64, who retired in May after working for 37 years at IBP in

Denison, now drives a truck part-time for a Carroll company.

Sporrer said he waited until several days after the drawing to begin telling people he won the big prize. He said he had fun listening to local speculation about the identity of the winner on radio reports while driving in his truck.

Sporrer bought his winning ticket at the Hy-Vee at 1426 Broadway in Denison. He chose to receive his jackpot as a lumpsum payment of \$1,646,341.46. He said he plans to continue working and likely will give a donation to a local college. He also thinks he'll buy a new truck.


