

ORDER

WHEREAS, a notice of the death of T. F. Driscoll, Senator from the First District of Iowa, having been conveyed to me, and the Forty-Seventh General Assembly, being now in regular session; and

WHEREAS, I, the undersigned, Nelson G. Kraschel, Governor of the State of Iowa, have heretofore issued a writ of election declaring a vacancy in the office of State Senator in the First District of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the Forty-Seventh General Assembly of the State of Iowa is now in regular session; I, Nelson G. Kraschel, Governor of the State of Iowa, by authority of the law in me vested, do hereby direct and order that there be held in the First Senatorial District of Iowa a special election on the tenth day of March, 1937, for the purpose of electing a Senator in the First Senatorial District of Iowa to fill the vacancy caused by the death of the said T. F. Driscoll; and

I HEREBY DIRECT AND ORDER that the County Auditor of Lee County, Iowa, proceed to provide for the holding of such election on said date as by law provided.
