Overview

In September and October of 2008, the lowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) collaborated with schools in lowa to conduct the 2008 lowa Youth Survey (IYS). The 2008 IYS is the twelfth in a series of surveys that have been completed every three years since 1975. The survey is conducted with students in grades 6, 8, and 11 attending lowa public and private schools. The IYS includes questions about students' behaviors, attitudes, and beliefs, as well as their perceptions of peer, family, school, neighborhood, and community environments.

Background

Prior to 1999, surveys were given to a sample of students in 6th, 8th, 10th, and 12th grades from approximately one-third of lowa's public school districts. In 1999, IYS participation was sought from *all* students in grades 6, 8, and 11 attending public school districts, as well as from students aged 14 to 18 years in alternative programs. This change made it possible to provide youth development data for each participating school district and each county in which participating students reside. The change also made it more feasible to use IYS results to aid in assessing outcomes of community and school youth development programs. It is important to note that the 1999 change in the grade level restricts direct comparisons with survey data collected prior to 1999, except for grades 6 and 8, in the specific schools that participated in the survey.

Beginning in 2002, IYS participation was also sought from all non-public schools. This change was made to more accurately reflect the attitudes and perceptions of all lowa students in grades 6, 8, and 11, not just those attending public schools. Data collected from students attending non-public schools are included in the 2002 and later reports.

In 2008, a change in the method used to conduct the survey took place. All 2008 lowa Youth Surveys were conducted via the internet and completed by students online through an electronic survey tool (SurveyMonkey) administered by lowa Department of Administrative Services in conjunction with lowa Department of Public Health. To ensure a smooth transition for this new procedure, an online pilot test took place in 2007 involving nine school districts. Prior to implementation of the 2008 IYS, training for school district personnel was held to provide instruction for online IYS administration via the lowa Communications Network (ICN).

Objective

The 2008 lowa Youth Survey State of lowa report is designed to help state-level planners, community agencies, and school personnel identify youth development needs, implement relevant, targeted interventions, and assess outcomes. IYS data can assist in providing a better understanding of students in lowa and their needs. It can also help to assess the strengths and challenges of schools, families, and communities from the young person's perspective. In addition, IYS data help the state obtain funding for a wide variety of programs and services. The lowa Youth Survey has proven to be a valuable resource in youth needs assessment, program development, implementation, and outcome evaluation.

lowa Youth Survey reports can also help lowa's schools, area education agencies, and counties assess their relative strengths and weaknesses. In addition to the State of lowa report, multiple population specific IYS reports are also publicly available. For more information, please check the IYS website: www.iowayouthsurvey.org for the availability of County, lowa Area Education Agency (AEA), Judicial District, lowa Department of Public Health Substance Abuse Prevention Service Area, and Trend reports. The total percentages provided in these additional reports, as

well as the breakdowns by grade level and gender, can be compared with the respective State of lowa report percentages to view similarities and differences by region or population.

2008 Iowa Youth Survey

Profile of Participation

The 2008 lowa Youth Survey was conducted September 29, 2008 through October 31, 2008. A total of 97,741 validated records were received from students across the state. Data in this report assumes each record represents one student. Validated records were received from 94,708 students attending public school districts, and 3,033 students attending non-public schools and a regent's institution. Records were identified from 347 of lowa's 362 public school districts (95.9%), and from 48 of the 184 non-public schools (26.1%), including one regent's institution, for students enrolled in grades 6, 8, or 11. These records may represent additional districts (e.g., when districts whole grade share). The 97,741 validated records received from students completing the IYS represented all 99 counties in lowa. Nearly all lowa counties were represented by a minimum of 200 students each.

Table 1 below provides the total number of students enrolled and the number and percent of students completing a validated 2008 IYS, by grade. The first column lists the grade. The second column provides the number of students enrolled in grades 6, 8, and 11, according to the lowa Department of Education. The third column displays the number of records from students who reported that they were in grades 6, 8, or 11 and completed a validated 2008 IYS. The fourth column provides the percent of students in each grade who completed a validated lowa Youth Survey. An additional 1,277 records from students indicating a grade of "ungraded" or "other" and 397 records from students with no grade indicated completed the survey and are not included in Table 1, but are included in the data reports.

Note: One thousand six hundred seventy-four IYS records did not have grade 6, 8, or 11 selected: these records are not included in this table.

Although the number of students participating in the 2008 IYS was slightly lower than in 2005, the number of total students enrolled in grades 6, 8, and 11 also declined. Despite the decrease in number, the percent of students participating in the 2008 IYS increased from 2005. In general, the higher the percentage of students completing the IYS, the more likely the data are representative of all students in grades 6, 8, and 11 residing in the state of lowa.

Survey Content

The 2008 lowa Youth Survey contains 198 questions and is divided into seven sections (A-G).

- Section A. Demographic Characteristics (14 questions)
- Section B. Things I Have Tried or Done and Things That Have Happened To Me (74 questions)
- Section C. My Beliefs and Attitudes (24 questions)
- Section D. Peer Questions (12 questions)

Section E. School Questions (30 questions)
Section F. Family Questions (20 questions)
Section G. Community Questions (24 questions)

A committee of youth development professionals was designated by IDPH to review and make recommendations regarding the 2008 survey questions. The selection of specific survey questions was based on analysis of question and response data collected in previous lowa Youth Surveys. The general content of the questions included in the 2008 IYS is similar to that of previous surveys. Most of the questions and response options from the 2005 IYS were utilized with little or no modification, and several new questions were added. Changes to the 2008 IYS include questions to elicit additional, more detailed information on gambling, nutrition, and exercise, as well as information regarding parental involvement in the military, students receiving accommodation under Section 504, students with Individualized Education Plans, and students receiving special education services.

The appropriateness of any comparison between the 2008 IYS to surveys from previous years must be considered on a question by question basis. It is important to note that in some cases, the question numbers have changed from year to year. The question wording, response options, and time frames may also have changed (for example the question regarding exercise changed from "on how many of the past seven days did you exercise or do physical activity for at least 20 minutes," in 2005, to "on how many of the past seven days did you exercise or do physical activity for a total of 60 minutes," in 2008). Trend analyses should be considered exploratory at best. If comparisons are made, the results may indicate that school districts appear to be significantly different, for better or worse, from the reports generated by previous surveys. However, this appearance may be due to differences in question wording and the representativeness of the sample rather than actual changes in lowa's youth.

<u>Data</u>

Data Cleaning

A total of 99,568 IYS records were received. Due to the change in format of the 2008 IYS (conducted online rather than written) many of the previously employed validity checks are no longer necessary. Following the data cleaning process, 1,827 records were removed, leaving a total of 97,741 validated lowa Youth Survey records. Data cleaning included cross referencing and matching internet protocol (IP) addresses with the custom data field (a unique link assigned to each school district), as well as confirming agreement that the school and building code entered by the student also matched the custom data field for each record. Date and time checks were also employed. Surveys conducted during the administration period designated by IDPH were accepted, and surveys conducted outside a ten hour period of acceptable school hours (for example surveys with start times of 2 a.m.) were deleted; 194 records with start times that did not fall within the date and time check were removed. Information obtained from census forms provided by school districts following survey administration was also reviewed to assist in data cleaning. Census form information was used to investigate discrepancies and also to identify specific records where surveys were mistakenly taken by students who should not have taken the IYS (for example, mistakenly taken by a class of 7th graders or retaken because of computer failure during the initial testing); 110 records were removed as requested on census forms. The IYS data was also compared with the Department of Education enrollment figures and as a result of information obtained from school districts, 141 additional records were identified as invalid and removed. Analysis was also performed to identify records with no responses recorded in Sections B through G (i.e., the non-demographic content of the survey). Since it was possible for a student to simply refuse to answer any question by leaving it blank,

not all of the records with missing responses were removed. In records where the grade variable (question A4) was also missing, records with no responses in Sections B through G were removed since they did not affect the response percentages or the weighting process. Additionally, records with grade level indicated as "ungraded" or "other" with no responses in Sections B through G were also removed since this did not affect the weighting procedure. As a result, 1,382 records with all responses in Sections B through G missing were removed. It is important to note that no mechanism was in place through the online survey service provider to identify if more than one record was submitted by the same student (duplicate records); therefore, it was not possible to identify potential duplicates in the data analysis.

Logic checks (data evaluated for conflicting, inconsistent, or illogical responses) were performed on the 2008 data. For each of the logic checks, groups of responses to multiple questions were compared. For example, responses to question B16 (During the past 30 days, on the days you smoked, how many cigarettes did you smoke per day?) were compared to the responses to question B28 (In the past 30 days, on how many days have you smoked cigarettes?). One group of questions, pertaining to cigarette use (questions B16, B17, B18), showed marginally conflicting, inconsistent, or illogical responses greater than 1%. The number of records failing logic checks in this group, though greater than 1%, was minimal and determined to be insignificant. Upon review of all logic checks, it was determined that many of the records may have shown conflicting responses due to the wording of the questions and/or response options, or student misinterpretation. When responses to a group of questions conflict, it is not possible to determine which answer accurately reflects the student's experience. No records were removed or changed as a result of the logic checks, however, possible causes of conflict should be considered when evaluating questions for future lowa Youth Surveys.

Weighting

Proportions of enrolled 6th, 8th, and 11th grade students completing the IYS varied and these differences presented a potential for bias. Therefore, all percentages in the data sections are weighted. Since 11th graders may be more likely to use substances than 6th or 8th graders, any significant discrepancy between the proportion of 11th grade students and the other grades who took part in the 2008 IYS would produce a distorted total estimate (i.e., different proportions of students in different grades could produce an artificially high or low total substance use estimate). A statistical weighting procedure reduces this potential bias and allows utilization of all validated data. The proportion of students in lowa enrolled in each grade was divided by the proportion actually completing an IYS. The resulting fraction is the weighting factor used in this report. Table 2, on the following page, provides a descriptive profile of the weights used. The first column lists the grade. The second column presents the percentage of students enrolled in grade 6, 8, or 11 out of the total number of students enrolled in those grades, according to the lowa Department of Education. The third column is the percentage of students completing the IYS who reported they were in each grade level. The fourth column is the weight applied so that the IYS data is adjusted to represent the population of students in grades 6, 8, and 11. Students who completed the IYS but did not report a grade of 6, 8, or 11 were assigned a weight of 1.

Data Interpretation

Since every school district did not collect data from every student, and home schooled students may not have been surveyed, there is the possibility that the students who completed the 2008 IYS are not representative of all students in Iowa. Additionally. IYS data do not represent vouth who may have dropped out of school. It is unknown what biases non-participating youth might introduce into the state report percentages. The 2008 lowa Youth Survey, as in previous years, is self-reported data and relies on each student's ability to read and honestly respond to each question. Since the 2008 IYS was conducted online, a student's ability to complete the survey is also dependent on possessing basic computer skills. Self-reported behaviors, attitudes, and beliefs are always subject to error (unintentional such as mistakenly selecting the wrong response or intentional such as denial or boasting), and it is not possible to identify records where this occurs. Additionally, some surveys contained missing data indicating that not all students answered every question. There are many potential reasons for missing data and why a student may choose not to answer a particular question including comprehension level (understanding survey language); confidentiality concerns; refusal to provide an answer resulting from lack of interest or motivation; beliefs and attitudes about the subject of the question; or inadvertently skipping a question. In general, the higher the proportion of students participating, the more likely the survey results are representative and without bias. When comparing data from population specific IYS reports to the state report, the higher the percentage of students that answered the question, the more likely it is that the comparisons with the state report percentages are unbiased.

To obtain an estimate of the total number of students in each grade that responded in a particular way to any question, change the percent reported for that response in the appropriate column to a decimal fraction and multiply it by the enrollment numbers provided in Table 1 on page 2. For example, if, in the "11th Grade Total" column, 50% of the grade 11 students who completed the IYS reported that they never gamble, multiply 0.50 times the total 11th grade enrollment number reported in Table 1. Since the data in the state report are weighted and rounded data, the resulting product of the multiplication would be an *estimate* of the total number of 11th graders who reported they never gamble.

Data Presentation

Section I: Data Tables

Data provided in the data tables include the responses to questions that appear in the 2008 lowa Youth Survey. One hundred ninety-five of the 198 IYS questions are represented and are presented on pages 11 through 89 (the first three questions regarding county number, school district number, and building number are not included in the data table section). The questions and responses provided in this report are written verbatim as appearing in the 2008 survey. Each table contains 13 columns. All percentages are rounded; "0%" appearing in any column represents anything less than 0.5% (including 0 or none). Due to rounding, percentages may

not add up to exactly 100%. All column percentages are weighted as described on page 4, except for data in the first table (which provides the number of validated IYS records).

The first row of the data tables describes the type of IYS report (i.e., state, county, etc.). The second row provides the question followed by the 2008 IYS section and question number. Below the question number in the first column are rows containing all possible response options provided on the IYS for that particular question. All percentages in the response rows are based on the number of students who answered that question; missing responses are not included in the calculation. The final row in the table provides the total percentage of all students in that column who responded to the particular question. A low percentage in the last row indicates that some students did not answer that question. In general, the higher the percentage responding, the more likely the responses are representative of students in lowa.

The second through fourth columns below the IYS question, titled "6th Grade," are weighted percentages based on all of the students in lowa who answered the question and reported that they were in grade 6. The "TOTAL" column combines all responses (including missing responses for gender), and is followed by data separated for male and female respondents.

Columns five through seven, titled "8th Grade," provide the data described as above for students reporting they were in grade 8. Columns eight through ten, titled "11th Grade," present the same data for students reporting they were in grade 11.

Columns eleven through thirteen, titled "All Grades," include the percentage of all students who reported each of the responses. The results in this column include all of the students in the previous nine columns, as well as an additional 1,674 students who did not choose grade 6, 8, or 11 when asked to select their grade in school.

Section II: Alcohol, Tobacco, and Other Drug Use Tables

The prevalence of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug (ATOD) use is presented in three tables on pages 90 and 91. Data in the tables include students who indicated current use (use during the past 30 days) as well as students who indicated ever using. All results in the ATOD tables indicate the percentage of records (or students) indicating use; any indication of use for any of the questions associated with that particular substance were coded as use. In accordance with computations in previous IYS reports, if all other responses in the record indicated no use, responses containing missing data were also coded as no use. Also consistent with previous IYS reports, if all responses were missing, the record is considered to indicate no use. Analysis was performed on missing data patterns to validate that it is reasonable to assume missing data were consistent with no use. Therefore, students who left a question blank are included in the denominator used to calculate the percentage of students who reported use. The criteria for substance use, ever and current, for alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs are defined below.

Alcohol Use

- Alcohol Use: Current Includes students who reported having at least one drink (glass, bottle, or can of beer; glass of wine, liquor, or mixed drink) in the past 30 days, or reported having five or more drinks on at least one day in the last 30 days. The section and question numbers from the 2008 IYS associated with these criteria are B26 and B30.
- Alcohol Use: Ever Includes students who reported an age when they started drinking; reported drinking five or more drinks on at least one day in the last 30 days; or had at least one drink in the

past 30 days. The section and question numbers associated with these criteria are B19, B26, and B30.

Tobacco Use

• Tobacco Use: Current

Includes students who reported having used a tobacco product in the past 30 days: cigarettes, cigars, or smokeless tobacco. This includes those who reported that they smoked at least part of a cigarette in the past 30 days; smoked cigarettes or cigars on one or more days in the past 30 days; or used smokeless tobacco in the last 30 days. The respective IYS section and question numbers are B16, B28, B29, and B38.

- Tobacco Use: Ever
 - Includes students who reported any of the following: that they smoked at least part of a cigarette in the past 30 days; that they had ever tried to quit smoking cigarettes; indicated an age when they started smoking cigarettes; indicated one or more days of smoking cigarettes or cigars in the past 30 days; or reported using smokeless tobacco in the last 30 days. The IYS section and question numbers associated with these criteria are B16, B17, B18, B28, B29, and B38.
- Cigarette Use: Current Includes students who reported they smoked at least part of one cigarette in the past 30 days, or reported one or more days of smoking cigarettes in the last 30 days. The respective IYS section and question numbers are B16 and B28.
- Cigarette Use: Ever
 Includes students who reported that they smoked at least part of one cigarette in the
 past 30 days; that they had ever tried to quit smoking cigarettes; reported an age when
 they started smoking cigarettes; or reported one or more days of smoking cigarettes in
 the past 30 days. The associated IYS section and question numbers are B16, B17, B18,
 and B28.
- Cigar Use: Current Includes students who reported one or more days of smoking cigars in the past 30 days. The IYS section and question number associated with this criterion is B29. The prevalence rate for ever using cigars is not provided since this question is not asked in the survey.
- Smokeless Tobacco Use: Current Includes students who reported using smokeless tobacco in the last 30 days. The associated IYS section and question number is B38.
- Smokeless Tobacco Use: Ever Includes students who reported that they had ever used smokeless tobacco. The associated IYS section and question number is B38.

Drug Use

 Drug Use: Current Includes students who reported use of a drug (amphetamines, cocaine, inhalants, marijuana, methamphetamines, or other illegal drug); use of prescription medications not prescribed for the student; use of over the counter medications different from the directions; or use of steroid pills or shots without a doctor's prescription in the past 30 days. The section and question numbers associated with these criteria are B31, B32, B33, B34, B35, B36, B37, B39, and B40.

Drug Use: Ever Includes students who reported use of a drug (amphetamines, cocaine, inhalants, marijuana, methamphetamines, or other illegal drug), or use of steroid pills or shots without a doctor's prescription in the past 30 days. Also included are students who reported an age of first use for drugs. The section and question numbers associated with these criteria are B20, B21, B22, B23, B24, B31, B32, B33, B34, B35, B36, B37, B39, and B40. (The prevalence rates for ever using over the counter medications different from the directions and ever using prescription medication not prescribed for the student are not provided since these questions are not asked in the survey.)

Section III: Construct Figures

A committee of State planners participated in an interactive process to identify key youth development related constructs that provide a summary of the data collected within nine framework domains. Thirty-four constructs and accompanying measures (questions derived from the IYS) were identified.

The data for selected questions are combined and presented in 34 figures on pages 92 through 118. Results are reported with the green shaded portion of the bar (on the left) representing the percent of respondents who responded favorably to all of the questions involved in computing a particular construct. The red shaded portion of the bar (on the right) represents the percent of respondents who responded unfavorably to at least one question associated with that construct. Some bars with equal percentages will not appear to be the same length because the bars represent exact percents and the percentage shown is rounded to the nearest integer. Due to rounding, percentages may not add up to exactly 100%. A list of questions and responses associated with each construct follow the construct figure. Unless noted, all response options for questions in each construct were the same. In accordance with computations in previous IYS reports, percentages in all except three of the construct figures are based on the number of students who answered the respective questions for each particular construct.

Records containing missing response data for any question were not included in the construct for 31 of the 34 constructs. As in previous reports, responses containing missing data for three of the constructs: No Current (past 30 days) Alcohol Use; No Current (past 30 days) Tobacco Use; and No Current (past 30 days) Illegal Drug Use, were included in the favorable category if all other responses in the record were also coded as favorable. If all responses were missing for questions included in these three constructs, the record was also coded as favorable. Analyses performed on missing data patterns suggested that it is reasonable to assume missing data were consistent with favorable responses.

Any comparison of the 2008 constructs with constructs from previous years must be approached with caution since questions have changed and some questions have been added. For example, the Helping Others construct changed considerably in 2008, likely due to a change in question wording. Additionally, the Gambling Avoidance construct also changed considerably in 2008 due to changes and additions made to the IYS questions on gambling. New composite scales were created for the gambling construct and a factor analysis was performed. The gambling construct was internally validated to address 2008 IYS changes. A listing of the framework domains, constructs, and associated questions is presented in Table 3 on the following page.

Recommendations

Based on analysis of the 2008 lowa Youth Survey data, the lowa Consortium for Substance Abuse Research and Evaluation respectfully offers the following recommendations for future lowa Youth Surveys:

- Review and possibly add or revise the lowa Youth Survey questions to better meet the needs of the lowa Department of Public Health and other participating entities. Consider how revisions would affect trend reporting.
- Review logic checks for groups of related questions. Focus on groups with conflicts equal to or greater than 1% to determine possible causes and effects on the data.
- Review and evaluate constructs to ensure validity. Examine changes in questions and/or question wording through the years for relevance and intended use as they relate to constructs. Consider how revisions would affect trend reporting.
- Review and discuss weighting procedures for IYS reports.
- When conducting the IYS online, information obtained from the census form is extremely
 useful and important for data cleaning and analysis. Review census form information and
 transmission options (e.g., online census forms) to ensure needed data is entered at time of
 survey to facilitate the data cleaning process.
- Discuss conducting the IYS every two years to assist providers in assessing the needs of lowa's youth and meeting the eligibility requirements for federal and other funding streams.
- Continue to encourage every public school district and non-public school to participate in
 future surveys. Communicate benefits of participation and continue to streamline the
 process to make it as easy as possible for school district personnel and students. Seek
 input from non-public school representatives on how to effectively increase participation for
 this population of students.


SAFE AND SUPPORTIVE SCHOOL CLIMATE










HEALTHY YOUTH - AVOIDANCE OF RISKY BEHAVIOR















YOUTH SUCCESSFUL IN SCHOOL






YOUTH ENGAGED IN/CONTRIBUTE TO COMMUNITY





Responses: "0 times" is coded as favorable and any response indicating one or more times of being bullied is coded as unfavorable.



2008 IYS Questions: E6. When a student is being bullied at school, how often do the teachers or other adults at school try to put a stop to it? **Response:** "Almost always" or "often" are coded as favorable and "almost never," "once in a while," or "sometimes" are coded as unfavorable.
