Answers to Your Common Lottery Questions...

How long does a player have to claim a prize?

The claim period varies by game.



- Instant tickets are valid for 90 days after the announced end of the game.
- Pull-tab ticket prizes must be claimed at the place where the ticket was sold.
- Iowa's Powerball and Hot Lotto tickets are valid for 365 days from the date of the drawing.
 - Iowa's \$100,000 Cash Game, Pick 3 and Pick 4 (both midday and evening) tickets are valid for 90 days from the date of the drawing.

t seems like an easy solution: you're out of ticket stock for your Extrema lotto terminal and you think you can just borrow a roll from your sister store across

town. However, the lottery cautions you not to do that!

Each roll of ticket stock for the Extrema lotto terminal is assigned to a particular store by Scientific Games - it is individually numbered and tracked. If you use a roll of stock that doesn't match your terminal, it can cause problems.

You may order ticket stock through your lotto terminal's "Special Functions" menu by generating a supply request, or you may call Scientific Games at 1-800-858-4744.

Lottery Transfers Nearly \$1 Million to Veterans Trust Fund

Gov. Chet Culver announced that the Iowa Lottery has transferred nearly \$1 million to the Iowa Veterans Trust Fund. The money marked the lottery's first quarterly transfer to the fund, which is designed to help Iowa veterans and their families.



"Iowa's veterans have served with dignity, and with excellence, and all veterans have the gratitude of every citizen," said Gov. Culver. "I was proud to sign this legislation earlier this year authorizing new lottery games to help support the Veterans Trust Fund. And now, the proceeds from those games will play a vital role in helping veterans and their loved ones around the state. I want to thank the efforts of Rep. McKinley Bailey, Sen. Daryl Beall, and all members of the Legislature who, through their actions, stood with Iowa's veterans. Together, we will continue to show these Iowa heroes our gratitude for their service to Iowa and the United States"

Legislation dedicating some lottery revenues to veterans' causes was signed into law by Gov. Culver in March. House File 2359 authorizes the Iowa Lottery to create two new instant-scratch and two additional pull-tab games each year. Profits generated from those games are used to support veterans and their families through the Iowa Veterans Trust Fund.

The lottery transfers proceeds to the state on a quarterly basis, and on Oct. 30, sent \$992,772.81 to the Veterans Trust Fund. The money was raised by the sale of lottery tickets from July through September.

"We're honored to have the opportunity to support those who have given so much for our country," said Ken Brickman, Iowa Lottery Acting CEO. "We thank our players for recognizing the importance of this cause and helping us provide a stable, ongoing source of revenue for the Iowa Veterans Trust Fund."

The lottery's first games to benefit the Trust Fund began sales in July. "Stars & Stripes," a \$1 game, is the first instant-scratch game dedicated to veterans' causes. It has a red, white and blue theme. "All American" is the first pull-tab game dedicated to the cause. Its \$1 tickets feature artwork of several patriotic symbols including the liberty bell, Statue of Liberty, Uncle Sam and the U.S. flag. The lottery's second set of games to benefit veterans are scheduled to begin sales in January.

"Everyone can have fun playing these games and know that the money generated from the sale of tickets is going to help our state's veterans," Brickman said.

The Iowa Veterans Trust Fund was created to assist qualified veterans in paying for expenses like travel to medical care facilities for wounded veterans; job training and unemployment, dental, vision and hearing assistance. The Fund can also benefit children of disabled or deceased veterans.

Cedar Rapids Woman Gets \$200,000 Halloween Surprise



Tina De Anda said she was just following her instincts when she purchased a \$200,000winning Powerball ticket.

"I bought my ticket four minutes before the cutoff," the Cedar Rapids woman said. "Something told me to go get one, so

I had to hurry. I was just at home cleaning and I had a feeling."

De Anda, 39, a single mother with two daughters, said she only plays Powerball sporadically and when she does make a purchase, it's for just one ticket.

"I still can't believe it happened," she said. "I thought never in my life it would happen to me, so that's unbelievable."

De Anda won her prize in the Oct. 29 Powerball drawing. Her ticket was just one number away from winning a share of the \$58.6 million jackpot, which was won by a ticket purchased in Pennsylvania. She purchased her ticket at the Hawkeye Convenience Store, 1581 First Ave. S.E. in Cedar Rapids.

De Anda said she didn't realize until Thursday night that she was a big winner. She said she had to run to a local grocery store to buy ingredients to make a treat for a Halloween potluck and while she was at the store, she had her ticket checked.

"It's not as much as you would get if you won the jackpot, but it's still a life-changing event for us," she said. "It opens up a lot of possibilities and makes life a little easier."

De Anda said she will use her winnings to pay off student loans, her car and the bill for one of her daughter's dental braces. After that, a family trip is in the works.
