Washington Woman Wins \$500,000 in Midwest Millions Drawing

Indianola Woman Also Selected as Winner of \$10,000 in January 15 Drawing

An eastern Iowa woman won a \$500,000 prize and five other lottery players from Iowa and Kansas won \$10,000 prizes Jan. 15 in a joint drawing by the Kansas and Iowa lotteries.

Kim Hertel of Washington was selected as the topprize winner of \$500,000 in the "Midwest Millions" drawing conducted by lottery officials in Topeka, Kan. Five winners of \$10,000 prizes also were selected in the drawing, including Diane Robinson of Indianola.

"This isn't a joke is it?" Hertel asked when she was

contacted by lottery officials. "\$500,000? For me? My legs are going numb, I have to sit down!"

Action Briefs

Remind Clerks to Sell Higher Priced Tickets

It just makes sense for Iowa Lottery retailers to encourage players to buy higher priced scratch tickets since retailers' commission is paid based on the sale price of tickets sold.

Lottery retailers receive a 5.5 percent sales commission on the sale price of all tickets sold — 7 percent sales commission for Gold Star retailers. So, retailers could receive more commission dollars by selling more higher priced scratch tickets.

Often lottery promotions are tied to the higher priced scratch tickets, like \$3, \$5 and \$10 tickets. It's easier to sell these tickets if you can tie them to an incentive like a second-chance promotion.

For example, remind players that if they purchase a Midwest Millions scratch ticket and they don't win a prize instantly, they may mail in the nonwinning ticket for a second-chance drawing and a chance to win up to \$500,000.

Upselling is beneficial to your bottom line, so remind clerks about it today!

The Kansas and Iowa lotteries became the first in the United States to offer a joint instant-scratch game when the initial version of Midwest Millions began sales in September 2007. The lotteries have built on that game's success with two more versions of the game, including the current Midwest Million game that began sales in September.

Iowa Lottery CEO Terry Rich said players' continued enthusiasm for the game was evident in strong sales of Midwest Millions in both states. Players sent in approximately 94,000 entries for the Jan. 15 drawing.

"The continued strong sales in Midwest Millions show that the game has delivered what players want: the chance to play for big prizes, but lots of smaller prizes as well," Rich said.

Kansas and Iowa split Midwest Millions' top prizes in the game's first two years, with Iowa Lottery players winning both \$500,000 prizes in the initial version of the game and Kansas Lottery players taking home both \$500,000 prizes in the game's second round.

Hertel, 50, a registered nurse who works at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Iowa City, said she and her husband both sent in tickets for the Midwest Millions drawing. She said they liked the game because of its Midwest theme and because it featured a second-chance drawing. She said she'll definitely share her winnings with her husband, Steve Stone.

"Oh yeah, our money is the same," she said. "I'm seeing a house being built now!"

Hertel also has a new set of wheels in mind.

"We live in the country and we have a car and an old pickup," she said. "And getting down the road in the winter is not really easy with the car, so I am going to get a pickup."

Tickets in this year's Midwest Millions game feature scenes of outdoor activities in both Kansas and Iowa. Players in both states are buying tickets and competing for prizes as part of one big pool. In addition to the prizes available in the Midwest Millions drawings, the \$10 game offers instant prizes ranging from \$10 to \$50,000. The game's second drawing will be April 16 in Des Moines. 4



Retailers May Receive \$500 Credit With Promo

lowa Lottery retailers that sell Mega Millions® with Megaplier® plays have a chance to receive a \$500 store credit!

There are 10 opportunities for retailers to receive store credit during the Mega Millions retailer promotion. Until the 250,000th Mega Millions with Megaplier play is sold, if an Iowa Lottery retailer sells a play that is one of the numbered plays listed below, they will receive a \$500 store credit. Each retail store may win more than once.

Retail store credits will be awarded for the following Iowa Lottery Mega Millions with Megaplier plays sold, as recorded on the Iowa Lottery online system database:

This retail promotion began on Jan. 31, 2010, when the first Iowa Lottery Mega Millions with Megaplier play was sold, and will continue through the date the 250,000th Mega Millions with Megaplier play is sold in Iowa. As of press time for this newsletter, the 250,000th ticket had not been sold yet.

The lottery will send a terminal message to notify all retailers when the \$500 store credits have been earned.

Ankeny Man Wins \$1 Million Playing Set For Life

An Ankeny man was in total shock when he realized he'd won the top prize of \$1 million playing the Iowa Lottery's "Set for Life" instant-scratch game.

Richard Bauder, 25, posed for a photo with Iowa Lottery CEO Terry Rich as he claimed his prize at the Iowa Lottery's headquarters in Des Moines. Bauder bought his winning ticket at Casey's, 1602 W. First St. in Ankeny.



Set for Life is a \$20 scratch game with eight top prizes of \$1 million. Players who win the top prize have the option of receiving it as an annuity or lump-sum payment. If the winner chooses to take the annuity, he/she will be paid \$40,000 per year for a period of 25 years.

Bauder chose the lump-sum payment, and he received \$650,000 before taxes.
