Policy

From the WIC Services Policy and Procedure Manual — 315.43 Actual Daily Time records

All local agency WIC personnel using the actual time as verified by daily time records option to document their QWIC hours must include specific amounts of time charged to WIC by functional cost categories (administration, client services, nutrition education and breast feeding promotion and support) on agency daily time records. The total portion of time allotted to each cost category is located on each daily time record.
