EPI Update for Friday, August 26, 2011 Center for Acute Disease Epidemiology (CADE) lowa Department of Public Health (IDPH)

Items for this week's EPI Update include:

- Influenza vaccine recommendations
- New zoonotic disease website

Influenza vaccine recommendations

It's estimated that between 166 and 173 million doses of influenza vaccine will be available in the U.S. this season; this season's flu vaccine has already begun arriving in lowa. Vaccinations should begin as the vaccine is available.

- This season's flu vaccine contains A/California/7/2009 (H1N1)-like, A/Perth/16/2009 (H3N2)-like, and B/Brisbane/60/2008-like.
- Flu vaccines are recommended for everyone 6 months of age and older.
- Children 6 months through 8 years receiving the flu vaccine for the first time require two doses of influenza vaccine (administered a minimum of four weeks apart) to optimize immune response.
 - Since this season's vaccine strains are unchanged from last year, children in this age group who received at least one dose of the 2010-11 seasonal vaccine will require only one dose of the 2011-12 vaccine.
 - Children in this age group who did not receive one dose of the 2010-11 seasonal influenza vaccine (or if it is unknown if the 2010-11 seasonal vaccine was received) should receive two doses of the 2011-12 seasonal influenza vaccine.
 - Note: in previous years, children 6 months through 8 years who received only one dose of influenza vaccine in their first year of vaccination required two doses the following season.
