# From the WIC Services Policy and Procedure Manual — 370.10a Clinic Services Record Audit

The purpose of the clinic services record audit is to assess WIC program compliance, data integrity and documentation. The clinic services record audit may be conducted as part of the office and/or clinic visits. Local WIC agencies are encouraged to use this tool for self-assessment activities throughout the year. A copy of the clinic services record audit is found in the policy and procedure manual.

#### **UPC Database**

#### What is the UPC Database?

Data is the representation of information in a manner suitable for communication, interpretation, storage and processing. A UPC database is a system intended to organize, store, and retrieve large amounts of <u>data</u> easily. It consists of an organized collection of data for one or more uses, typically in digital form.

A WIC National UPC Database is being developed. States will need to confirm that all authorized products have a UPC assigned to the approved WIC products that are available in their state. Information regarding private label/store brand items will be the responsibility of the state and the supplier/retailer.

UPC database stores WIC Approved product information including:

- UPC number
- Product description

- Product format
- Unit of measure
- Type of container
- Product category and
- Product subcategory
