Pursuant to 2011 Iowa Code section 307.31, the Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) is required to “review the current revenue levels of the road use tax fund and the sufficiency of those revenues for the projected construction and maintenance needs of city, county, and state governments in the future.” The report is required to be submitted to the Iowa General Assembly by December 31 every five years, beginning in 2011.
