

INSURANCE FRAUD

Do not sell or let anyone benefit from using your insurance information. <u>It's a CRIME!</u>

<u>Do not</u> let anyone use your personal information from your car or health insurance policy to file a fraudulent insurance claim of any kind.

When you give someone your insurance information:

- You may become a victim of identity theft.
- Your employer may become a victim of a crime.
- You may be criminally charged with insurance fraud.

Criminals want anyone's insurance information to file false insurance claims. Millions of dollars are paid every year to criminals filing false insurance claims. When false insurance claims are filed, consumers and employers pay the cost.

Do not let anyone tell you it is okay to file a false insurance claim. **It is against the law.** Allowing someone to use your insurance information to file a false claim is also against the law.

> <u>The criminal penalty for Insurance Fraud is up to</u> <u>5 years in prison/\$7500 fine</u>
