
## U.S. 63 Dedication

## Chester, Iowa November 24, 1982



## **Project Description**

The 54-year-old bridge over the Upper Iowa River in Chester was built in 1928 by the A. Olson Construction Company at a cost of \$25,219.

Work on construction the new 268-foot by 44-foot prestressed concrete beam bridge began in June 1982. The new bridge was built in the same location as the old one. A total of approximately 800 feet of U.S. 63 at the ends of the bridge was graded and paved with portland cement concrete.

The cost of constructing the new bridge was \$324,227 and the costs of grading and paving totaled \$140,327. Right of way costs amounted to \$3,688.
