The Iowa Lottery began rolling out its new TouchPlay machines (TPM) to licensed retailers in Iowa earlier this month.

## Two Manufacturers Now Certified

The Iowa Lottery Board has certified Diamond Games of Chatsworth, Calif., and Oasis Gaming of Omaha, Neb., as manufacturers of TouchPlay machines. More than 130 applications have already been received from businesses and nonprofit clubs that want to offer the TouchPlay machines to their customers. Most establishments, such as taverns, will be limited to two machines, while fraternal or charitable social clubs can have up to four machines at each site. More than 40 amusement companies have been certified to install the machines. In the beginning stages of rollout, machines are only being placed in liquor-by-the-drink establishments.

## TouchPlay Machines First for U.S. Lottery

TouchPlay machines are unique because players insert money into the machines as they do with any other vending machine. However, after the ticket is dispensed, the machine’s video monitor displays the results of the ticket while entertaining electronic tones indicate whether the ticket has won a prize.

The Iowa Lottery began exploring the concept in late 2001 after talking with some of the companies that produce the machines. While the machines are offered at some Indian gaming locations and other casinos, they had never before been offered by a U.S. lottery.

## Legislature-Approved Concept

The lottery then approached the Iowa Legislature with the concept. After lawmakers’ initial review of the concept, Iowa Lottery officials asked legislators for direction as to whether to proceed. In May 2002, the Iowa Legislature passed a budget bill that included language authorizing the lottery to develop a business plan for the machines’ deployment. Beginning in May 2003, the lottery tested 30 machines from three manufacturers in the field.

## At A Glance.

On This Date in Iowa Lottery History . . .
May 15, 1985—Nineteen years ago, Gov. Terry Branstad signed the Lottery Bill into law. Within 111 days after the signing, an instant ticket vendor (Scientific Games), a network of more than 3,000 retailers, a staff of 112 , five regional offices and a central headquarters were assembled. Also, advertising strategies were mapped out, tickets and promotional materials were printed and distributed and accounting systems and communication links were established. The lottery's launch occurred on Aug. 22, 1985.

# Casinos Become More Unique Destinations 

Isle of Capri and Rhythm City Casinos are proud that they're very unique casino destinations.
