**Legal Authority** Code of Iowa, Chapter 192

**Job Description** A farm bulk milk hauler grades, samples, and measures the milk in a farm bulk tank to check for off-odors and off-flavors and determines the amount to be picked up. They pump the milk from the tank and deliver it to a dairy plant, receiving station or transfer station.

**Education & Experience Required** Applicants must be at least 16 years of age; however, no formal education or training is required. Licenses for haulers from other states are accepted if Iowa has a reciprocal agreement with that state.

**Continuing Education** Applicants are required to attend hauler school every three years.

**Examination** The hauler must pass exams that are administered at the worker's location at the employer's request. A person can prepare for the exams by studying manuals from the Department of Agriculture.

**Fees** Application: \$10 – Grader/hauler  
Duration: One year (July 1 – June 30)  
Renewal: \$10 – Grader/hauler  
Other: Fees may be paid either by the employer or the individual.
