

LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE (LPN)

Job Description Licensed practical nurses work as direct caregivers in a variety of settings including acute and long-term care under the supervision of a registered nurse or physician. They are members of the health care team working primarily with individuals and families. Nursing skills are based upon knowledge of natural, biological and social sciences, nursing theory and practice.

Education & Experience Required An applicant must be a high school graduate or equivalent; graduate from an approved school of nursing at the practical nurse level; and, pass the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX-PN). Practical nurse programs are the equivalent of one year and include both classroom study and clinical practice.

Foreign applicants seeking initial LPN licensure in Iowa must be reviewed by the Commission on Graduates of Foreign Nursing Schools (CGFNS) Credential Evaluation Service prior to taking the NCLEX-PN exam. CGFNS provides primary source verification of educational preparation and licensure in the native country. Applications must earn a minimum Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of 500.

Continuing Education Twenty-four contact hours or 2.4 continuing education units are required for renewal of an initial license issued for less than three years.

Thirty-six contact hours or 3.6 continuing education units are required for renewal of a license issued for three years.

Examination The national computerized examination (NCLEX-PN) is administered year round at approved Sylvan Prometric Technology Centers in Bettendorf and Urbandale, Iowa. After October 1, 2002, the examination will be administered at approved Pearson Professional Centers in Davenport, Des Moines, and Sioux City, Iowa.
