Iowa Community College Fall 2004 **Credit Student Enrollment Report**

lowa Community Colleges transmit fall enrollment data to the Department of Education after the 14th day of the fall term start date. All data included in this report, except where noted, are taken from the Management Information System (MIS) electronic data files and are confirmed by the community college. Fall 2004 unduplicated credit headcount enrollment of 81,803 demonstrates an increase of 3,522 (4.50%) over Fall 2003 unduplicated credit headcount enrollment of 78,281. The majority (53.77%) of Fall 2004 enrollees were enrolled during Fiscal Year 2004 (July 2003 - June 2004).




Figure 1 Iowa Community College Fall Credit Enrollments Fall 2000, Fall 2001, Fall 2002, Fall 2003, and Fall 2004

Total Enrollment by Program Type: Community college fall credit enrollment continues to grow, with approximately 56 percent pursuing College Parallel program majors (see Figure 1). College Parallel program enrollment increased 1,554 (3.50%) from 44,430 in Fall 2003 to 45,984 in Fall 2004. Career Technical enrollment increased 1,696 (5.90%) from 28,740 to 30,436 over the same time period, and College Parallel/Career Option (preparation for a vocation and transfer to a four-year institution), increased 285 (5.42%) from 5,257 to 5,542. Total enrollment of 81,962, includes duplicated headcount of 159 students enrolled in more than one program.

The ratio of full-time to part-time students is 51.07 percent to 48.93 percent; however, there are differences across the colleges. The percentage of full-time students ranges from a high of 67.58 percent at Indian Hills Community College to a low of 40.00 percent at Western Iowa Tech Community College.






Figure 2 Residency of Fall 2004 Credit Enrollees

Residency of Students: Iowa's Community Colleges are noted for attracting Iowa residents. As Figure 2 indicates, 94.48 percent of Fall 2004 enrollees are lowa residents.

Gender of Students: Consistent with national trends in postsecondary education, the majority of community college students are female. (See Figure 3)



<u>High School Students</u>: Iowa's Community Colleges help serve the needs of high school students. As Figure 4 indicates, 18.55 percent of Fall 2004 enrollees are high school students. However, as Figure 5 shows, high school students only take 8.95 percent of the total credits taken during Fall 2004 at Iowa Community Colleges. A regular student is enrolled for an average of 10.90 credits, while high school students average 4.71 credits.




As Figure 6 indicates, a large majority (77.55%) of high school students are enrolled in College Parallel courses. This compares with Figure 7 that shows a smaller majority (51.22%) of regular students enroll in College Parallel courses.



<u>Age of Students</u>: Over sixty-five percent (65.76%) of the total credit enrollment is 22 years or less, with 20.00 percent 17 years of age or under. The age distribution is described in Table 2 and illustrated in Figure 8.

Age Distribution of Fall 2004 Credit Enrollees



The average age of Iowa Community College students enrolled on the 14th day of the 2004 fall term is 23.50 years. This continues a 5-year trend of decreasing average age among Iowa Community College fall enrollees. This trend is represented in Table 3.

Ethnicity of Students: As shown in Table 4 below, minority enrollments at lowa's Community Colleges comprise 9.29 percent of the total enrollees that reported ethnicity. According to the 2000 census 7.4 percent of the general population in Iowa were minorities. Table 4 further indicates minority enrollments at Iowa's Community Colleges have increased 0.34 percent of enrollees that reported ethnicity from 8.95 percent in Fall 2003 to 9.29 in Fall 2004.




Figure 9 Program Major of Fall 2004 Credit Enrollees

<u>Student Program Majors</u>: Approximately 56 percent of community college students are enrolled in College Parallel programs. The Health (15.07%) programs enroll the largest number of Career/Technical Preparatory students followed by Industrial Technology (12.32%) and Business (10.78%). These data are illustrated in Figure 9.
