## Basic Raffle Facts

Ticket Sales: Start of business Sept. 23 Midnight, Oct. 31, 2013

Drawing:
Nov. 1, 2013, conducted by the MultiState Lottery Association
Price: $\quad \$ 10$ each
Availability: Tickets are being sold in Iowa, Indiana, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, Ohio and Oklahoma.

Top Prizes: At least two top prizes of $\$ 1$ million will available in the multi-state drawing. If set sales thresholds are met, more $\$ 1$ million prizes will be awarded.
Runner-Up: If a participating state does not have a million-dollar winner, a $\$ 50,000$ prize will be awarded in a separate drawing to someone who bought a ticket in that state.


## How to Sell a Raffle Ticket



1. Press the "Halloween Millions Raffle" button, which is located on Page 2 of the "Games" screens on the lottery terminal. Then choose the button that corresponds to the number of tickets the player wants to purchase, up to 10 (See graphic above).
2. After a screen about the amount of purchase is displayed and the clerk chooses "Yes," the lottery terminal will produce a raffle ticket with a unique eight-digit number. Ticket numbers are issued in numerical order. (An approval code is required for transactions of $\$ 50$ and over.)
3. Raffle tickets are easy pick only. Players may not pick their own raffle numbers.
4. Raffle tickets cannot be cancelled.
5. Remind players they must KEEP THEIR TICKETS to check them against the winning raffle numbers and to claim a prize.
