## Which Games Can Be Cancelled? Find Out Here!

Here's a review for everyone regarding which games' tickets can be cancelled and which ones cannot, plus an overview of the Ticket Allowance Program.

## Which Games Can Be Cancelled?



Tickets from the \$100,000 Cash Game, Pick 3 and Pick 4 games can be cancelled, but there are some rules to follow when cancelling. Tickets must be cancelled the same day in the same store where they were sold and before the sales cutoff time for the game
Follow this procedure to cancel a lotto ticket:

- Touch the "Cash/Cancel" tab on the main screen
- Touch "Cancel Ticket" (screen is shown above)
- Scan the bar code on the ticket using the document scanner or the scanner on the front of the printer. You may also manually enter the numbers using the keypad, then touch "OK" to accept the serial number and submit it for cancellation.


## Which Games Can't Be Cancelled?

You will NOT be able to cancel plays for the Powerball, Hot Lotto or Mega Millions games.
If you run one of these tickets through the terminal, you will receive a prompt informing you that the ticket is not eligible to be cancelled. This includes jammed or misprinted tickets.

## Automatic Additional 0.1 Percent Allowance

The Iowa Lottery now issues to all on-line retailers an additional 0.1 percent of ALL on-line games sales added to the base commission rate of 5.5 percent each week. The 0.1 percent applies to all on-line games, not just the games that cannot be cancelled.

You will earn extra commission every week, even when you don't have any error tickets. And you can sell non-damaged tickets to another customer.

## Answers to Common Lottery Questions...

Q. What are the sales cutoff times for Iowa's lotto games?
A. It depends. For Powerball ${ }^{\circledR}$ and Mega Millions ${ }^{\circledR}$, the sales cutoff time is $8: 59$ p.m. on the
 day of the drawing. For Hot Lotto ${ }^{\circ}$ and the Pick 3 and Pick 4 evening drawings, the sales cutoff time is $8: 18$ p.m. the day of the drawing. For the Pick 3 and Pick 4 midday drawings, players cannot purchase tickets for that drawing after 12:30 p.m. For Iowa's \$100,000 Cash Game, the cutoff is $8: 18$ p.m. on the day of the drawing.

## Q. Why is there a sales cutoff time?

A. All lottery games involve a high level of security controls that take time to administer. Officials must ensure that proper procedures are followed. The Iowa Lottery wants its games to be completely fair and honest. A number of measures ensure that every ticket issued in a lottery game has the same chance of winning.

## Fairfax Woman Reinvests, Wins $\$ 100,000$ Playing New 'Game Book'

After winning a $\$ 20$ prize the first time she played the lottery's new "Game Book" scratch game, a Fairfax woman decided to try the game again and ended up winning the first top prize of $\$ 100,000$.

Andrea Sauser, 41, was on break at work when she scratched the ticket.
"I was chatting with my friend as I was scratching the ticket, telling her that our other friend had won $\$ 100$ last night on the Ten Times game and she was the luckiest person I knew," Sauser said. "I said, 'It doesn't look very good,' and then I scratched off a '7' on the Game Book on the 'Golden 7 s ' and it said a hundred thousand!"

Sauser said news spread quickly throughout the sales office of Yellowbook in Cedar Rapids.
"Everybody was screaming and hollering," Sauser said as she claimed her prize.
After having her ticket validated at a retailer, Sauser decided to take the remainder of the day off to collect her thoughts and claim the prize. She called her husband, Dennis, to tell him the good news.
"He's like, 'Are you kidding?' and I'm like, 'No,' and he just started laughing," Sauser said.
Sauser purchased her winning ticket at Casey's, 5655 C St. SW in Cedar Rapids. She said she is planning to save her winnings for now.

## Scanning and Processing Coupons Quickly and Easily

New to scanning coupons? Need a refresher? Here's the procedure:

- Hold the bar code under the red light of the bar code scanner
- A pop-up screen asks if the player wants an easy pick or to use a play slip (see top graphic)
- Press "Easy Pick" button for an easy pick
- Insert a play slip to use that option
- Press "Cancel" if the player doesn't know if they want an easy pick or play slip, or doesn't have a play slip ready (pressing Cancel at this point does not void the coupon)
- Once the player has decided which option they want, scan the coupon again and complete the process

NOTES: Coupons may only be used once. If a coupon has already been redeemed, the terminal will give an error message: "Coupon Already Redeemed" (see bottom graphic).

Keep the coupons to balance your cash drawer; Lottery reps will not pick them up. Retailers should appropriately destroy the bar code and dispose of the coupon so it cannot be presented again.



Wen you validate a lotto ticket for a player that still has drawings remaining on it, one of two things will happen, depending on if the ticket is a winner or not.

1) If the ticket is a nonwinner at the time of scanning, yet draws remain, a receipt will print out that says, "Not Yet a Winner More Draws Remain" (pictured at left). Also, a screen will pop up on the Wave terminal (like that pictured at left below the receipt) indicating there are drawings left on the ticket. No exchange ticket is printed with a nonwinner.
2) If the ticket is a winner, yet more draws remain, receipts will print for the winning ticket (customer and retailer receipts) and then an exchange ticket will be printed with the same numbers on it and it will say "Exchange" on it (shown at left). In this case, be sure to give the player the "Exchange" ticket so it can be validated for the drawings remaining on the ticket after they have been held.
