On April 12, the Iowa Lottery held its first drawing to select the first three winners in its Warehouse Dash promotion.

The three winners, Ruben Cardona of Lowden, Melissa Kramer of Marshalltown and Jan Peterson of Harlan, will travel to the lottery's Points for Prizes"' warehouse in Chicago, May 11-13, and participate in a 90 -second dash through the prize warehouse to grab as much top-brand merchandise as they can.
These three Warehouse Dash winners will have the chance to grab items offered in the VIP Club's online prize store, which includes televisions and other sought-after electronics, housewares, jewelry, camping gear, sporting equipment and more. Each winner will get to choose a partner to accompany them on their weekend getaway to Chicago and in the dash itself.
"There's no doubt the winners are going to have a great experience running through the warehouse and grabbing all of their favorite items," Lottery CEO Terry Rich said. "They may want to start practicing now for their 90 -second dash."
If players who entered for the first drawing didn't get selected, their entries are automatically entered in the second drawing in May. If players haven't entered to win yet, they can enter the promotion by first joining our VIP Club, if they're not already a member. Players should then purchase a "Did I Win" scratch ticket and if they don't win instantly, they can enter the ticket online.

The lottery will hold one more drawing to determine the second set of three contestants for the next Warehouse Dash. The second round of winners will be selected in a drawing May 23 for the same weekend getaway package June 22-23. The deadline to enter that drawing is noon on May 21. $\$ 10,000$ Powerball Prize Nearing Expiration


The deadline is approaching for an unclaimed $\$ 10,000$-winning Powerball ticket sold in Council Bluffs, and the Iowa Lottery is reminding players to double-check their tickets to see if they have the big winner.
"Wherever you keep your tickets, double-check them. Some big prizes are on the line," Iowa Lottery CEO Terry Rich said.
The $\$ 10,000$-winning ticket was sold at No Frills Supermarket, 1817 W. Broadway in Council Bluffs, for the Powerball drawing on Wednesday, May 11, 2011. It came close to winning it all, matching four of the first five numbers and the Powerball to win a $\$ 10,000$ prize. The winning numbers that night were: $9-17-32-43-45$ and Powerball 31.

The winner or winners have until the close of business at 4 p.m. on May 11 to claim the prize at a lottery office. The Iowa Lottery has offices in Council Bluffs, Storm Lake, Mason City, Des Moines and Cedar Rapids.
In fiscal year 2011, nearly $\$ 1.4$ million in prizes went unclaimed in Iowa lotto games. Unclaimed prizes in Iowa go into prize pools for future lottery games.
Players in Iowa have up to 365 days from the date of the drawing to claim prizes in Powerball, Mega Millions ${ }^{\circ}$ and Hot Lotto ${ }^{\circ}$. Players have up to 90 days from the date of the drawing to claim prizes in Iowa's $\$ 100,000$ Cash Game and the Iowa Lottery's Pick 3 and Pick 4 games.

Be cancelled before the sales cutoff time for the game.
Follow this procedure to get proper credit:

- Touch the "Cash/Cancel" tab.
- Touch "Cancel Ticket" button/icon (See the screen example above.)
- Scan the Ticket/Play through the Doc Scanner and the ticket will be branded with: CANCEL $\$ x . x x$ (whatever the dollar amount was) and the Date.
- OR, scan the bar code on the lotto ticket/Play using the Bar Code Reader (BCR) on the front of the printer.
- OR, manually enter the numbers using the keypad. The serial number displays in the keypad display window.
- Touch "OK" to accept the serial number and submit it for cancellation.


## Buffalo Center Man Trusts Instincts, Wins $\$ 100,000$ Prize

A Buffalo Center man said his gut feeling was right when he chose to play the lottery's "Did I Win?" scratch game and ended up winning a top prize of \$100,000.

Travis Trushcheff, 25, said he just uses his intuition when choosing which scratch games to play, and this time it paid off.
"We just said, 'Well, maybe we'll try those," Trushcheff said.

Trushcheff said he was traveling with
 his fiancée, Stacey Miller, when they stopped at Cenex Ampride, 1301 Tenth Ave. N. in Humboldt, and picked up the ticket.
"She called most of our family," Trushcheff said. "I had to send a picture of the ticket over to them because they couldn't believe it, really."

Trushcheff claimed his prize at the Iowa Lottery's regional office in Mason City. He said he only took an hour off work as a mechanic/truck driver to claim his prize.
"I'm kind of a workaholic," Trushcheff said with a laugh. "They were wondering why I even came in this morning."

Trushcheff said he and Stacey plan to use some of the winnings to put toward their upcoming wedding, as well as pay off a house they just purchased.

Did I Win? is a $\$ 10$ scratch game. If players find a "yes" symbol, they win the prize shown for that symbol. If they find the "coin" symbol, they win double the prize shown for that symbol. If they find the "gold" symbol, they win all 20 prizes shown. The overall odds of winning a prize in the game are 1 in 3.35 .
Players can enter eligible nonwinning scratch tickets online to earn "Points For Prizes ${ }^{\mathrm{mmN}}$ points. The point value will be revealed to the player on the website upon successful submission of each eligible valid ticket. There is a limit of 30 ticket entries per day. To participate in Points For Prizes ${ }^{\mathrm{min}}$, a player must register for a free account at ialottery.com. Registration is a one-time process. Merchandise that can be ordered by using points will be listed on the website in the Points For Prizes ${ }^{\mathrm{mw}}$ online store. Players can choose from items in categories such as apparel, automotive, jewelry, sporting, tools and more.

Since the lottery's start in 1985, its players have won more than $\$ 2.8$ billion in prizes while the lottery has raised more than $\$ 1.3$ billion for the state programs that benefit all Iowans.
