## Action Briefs

## Check For Credit Versus Debit Cards

Remember that there's a big difference between a debit card and a credit card - even though they may look the same. Many banks offer their customers debit cards that can be used to withdraw money from their checking or savings account.


If a lottery player hands you a card, it's important that you ask the player which kind of card they are using before you make the transaction. Lottery players can use debit cards to purchase lottery products. However, state law prohibits the use of credit cards to make a lottery purchase. Avoid inconveniencing your customers by checking carefully any card presented to you.

## Answers to Your Lottery Questions....

## How are lottery proceeds in Iowa used?

Today, lottery proceeds in Iowa have three main purposes: They provide support for veterans, help for a variety of significant projects through the state General Fund, and backing for the Vision Iowa program, which was implemented to create tourism destinations and community attractions in the state and build and repair schools.

Can nonprofit organizations here in Iowa apply for funding from the lottery?

All lottery profits in Iowa go into the state's general fund or the Veterans Trust Fund as appropriated by the Legislature and approved by the governor. It would require legislation to earmark funds for any particular cause.

## Super Tech Receives More Than Two Million Entries, Smashing Previous Record

## Six Lucky Players Win Super Prizes in Super Tech Promotion, 250 Others Also Win Electronics Prizes



The Iowa Lottery's holiday promotion that just concluded set records again as players flooded their VIP Club accounts with entries into "Super Tech."
On Jan. 24, the lottery held drawings in its Super Tech promotion to determine the winners of the electronics prizes offered. The original version of the Tech The Halls concept in 2009 had set records for the lottery. More than 405,000 entries were received in that promotion, the most entries the lottery had ever received in a single web-based promotion since it began offering them in November 2001.

The second time Tech the Halls was offered, the lottery saw yet another record, receiving 844,000 entries in 2010. But this year's version of the lottery's techie promotion, called Super Tech, set the bar even higher with more than 2.1 million entries.
"This just shows us how popular technology-based products are in our world today," said Iowa Lottery CEO Terry Rich. "We're glad to see our players were so excited about the Sony ${ }^{\oplus}$ electronics and Super Prizes offered in Super Tech."
Players entered their non-winning holiday-themed scratch tickets in the promotion for a chance to win one of 250 Sony electronics prizes or one of six Super Prize packages. Each prize package included: Sony ${ }^{\circledR}$ BRAVIA ${ }^{\bullet}$ 46-inch HDTV, Sony ${ }^{\oplus}$ NEX-C3 digital camera, Sony ${ }^{\oplus}$ Tablet ${ }^{\text {tw }}$ S (16GB), Sony ${ }^{\ominus}$ PlayStation ${ }^{\ominus} 3$ (160GB), Sony ${ }^{\oplus}$ 3D Blu-ray Disc ${ }^{\text {ma }}$ home theater system and $\$ 2,000$ cash. ## Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division, lowa Lottery Partner on Trucks

The Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division (ABD) has partnered with the Iowa Lottery to provide rolling billboards featuring Iowa Lottery campaigns.

Two ABD delivery trucks were recently outfitted with graphics highlighting the lottery proceeds that benefit Iowa veterans and their families through the Iowa Veterans Trust Fund, and the lottery games that provide funding for other vital causes through the state General Fund.
One truck features the Lottery's Veteran tickets. This trailer travels 800 miles statewide per week and spends over 1,100 hours on the road annually. Since 2008, the Iowa Lottery has sold games to raise nearly $\$ 10$ millions for Iowa veterans and their families. Proceeds from Veterans ticket sales go to the Iowa Veterans Trust Fund.


"The Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division is excited to partner with the Iowa Lottery to feature games that benefit state programs," ABD Administrator Stephen Larson said. "These mobile advertisements publicize what the Iowa Lottery has to offer."
The ABD has also provided the Iowa Lottery with a 53-foot tractor-trailer to feature the Lottery's "It's your dream... anything can happen!" campaign. This trailer travels 1,000 miles statewide per week, spending over 2,200 hours on the road annually.
Iowa Lottery CEO Terry Rich thanked the Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Division for suggesting the idea of outfitting its delivery trucks with messages about lottery benefits for the state.
"This is a really inventive way to talk about the great things happening in Iowa," Rich said. "We've made that one of our goals and we're happy to work with another state entity to help spread the word."
