HOW TO USE THIS DOCUMENT

Entries follow the format of the main section of IOWA AND SOME IOWANS, 3RD EDITION. They are in Dewey Decimal order with Fiction last. The entry format itself is author (if pertinent). Title. Publisher, date. Pages. Price (ca indicates circa or estimated). The second paragraph is the annotation which includes an indication of interest level (IL) if known. The third paragraph gives suggested subject headings when available.

The custom of marking titles which might be particularly useful to schools is continued. An asterisk (*) appears before the Dewey Decimal or other call number.
