Promoting Collaboration Between Empowerment and Legislatively Identified Funding Streams (December 2002)

The lowa Empowerment Board was directed by legislation to regularly make information available identifying funding distributed through specified funding streams. The intent is that community empowerment area boards and the administrators of the programs located within the community empowerment areas shall fully cooperate with one another in order to avoid duplication, enhance efforts, combine planning, and take other steps to best utilize the funding to meet the needs of the families in the areas. It should be noted that some of the programs are annual grants and recipients may not receive funding on an on-going basis.
