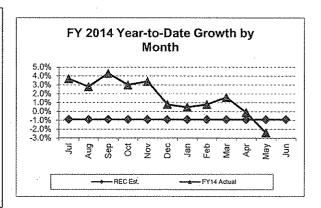

May 2014 General Fund Receipts

Gross General Fund receipts for May 2014 totaled \$851.0 million, a decrease of 16.8 percent over the same period last year. There was one more processing day in May 2013 than this past May. Fiscal year-to-date, gross General Fund receipts totaled \$7,060.7 million or -2.4%. The current estimate for FY2014 is -0.9 percent.

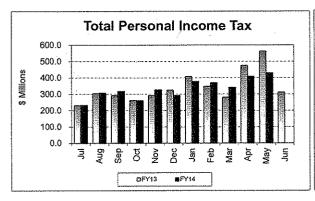
## <u>Summary</u>

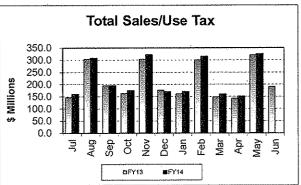
Fiscal year-to-date gross receipts are 2.4 percent lower compared to May 2013. The current estimate for FY2014 is a growth rate of -0.9 percent for gross receipts. The drop of gross receipts this May was larger than anticipated, especially in final return payments and corporate taxes. Fortunately withholding tax receipts and sales/use taxes continue to meet estimates.



### Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax receipts totaled \$428.7 million during May 2014. This is \$131.6 million or 23.5 percent less than the receipts of May 2013. Withholding tax receipts increased \$14.0 million or 4.8 percent compared to last year. Estimated payments decreased \$7.7 million. Final return payments decreased \$137.9 million. Fiscal year-to-date, personal income tax receipts totaled \$3,655.7 million, a decrease of 3.1 percent. The current estimate for personal income tax for Fiscal Year 2014 is for a decrease of 1.0 percent.



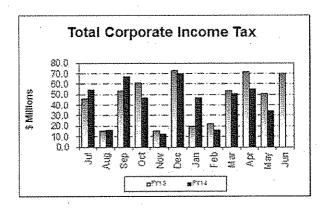


### Sales/Use Tax

May sales/use tax receipts totaled \$324.0 million, which represents an increase of \$4.2 million or 1.3 percent over May 2013. Fiscal year-to-date, sales/use tax receipts totaled \$2,450.3 million, an increase of 3.9 percent. The current estimate for sales/use tax for Fiscal Year 2014 is for an increase of 4.0 percent.

### Corporate Income Tax

Corporate income tax receipts during May totaled \$33.9 million, which is \$17.3 million or 33.8 percent less than in May 2013. Fiscal year-to-date corporate income tax receipts totaled \$469.9 million, a decrease of 3.2 percent. The REC's estimate for corporate income tax for Fiscal Year 2014 is for an increase of 5.4 percent.



### Refunds

For the month of May, the Department of Revenue issued \$58.6 million in refunds on a cash basis. This compares to \$74.2 million issued May 2013. For the fiscal year-to-date, total refunds issued on a cash basis were \$930.3 million. This compares to \$791.5 million issued at this time last year.
