Auditor of State Mary Mosiman today released a report on Iowa State University of Science and Technology, Ames, Iowa for the year ended June 30, 2014. Iowa State University of Science and Technology previously released its annual financial report for the year ended June 30, 2014.

Iowa State University of Science and Technology is governed by the Board of Regents. For the year ended June 30, 2014, the full-time equivalent student enrollment was 33,171 with an average cost per student of \$12,585, compared to 31,119 students and an average cost per student of \$12,661 for the year ended June 30, 2013.


