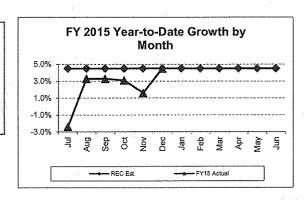

December 2014 General Fund Receipts

Gross General Fund receipts for December 2014 totaled \$677.7 million, an increase of 20.0 percent over the same period last year. Over one-third of the increase is due to the location of the Thanksgiving holiday in relation to the end of November this year. The deposit of approximately \$41.6 million was delayed from November and instead deposited December 1 this year. Fiscal year-to-date, gross General Fund receipts totaled \$3,749.7 million or 4.5 percent increase over the same period last year. The current estimate for Fiscal Year 2015 is 4.5 percent.

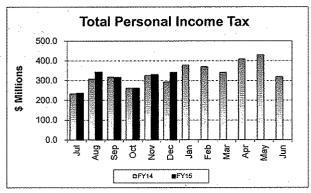
### Summary

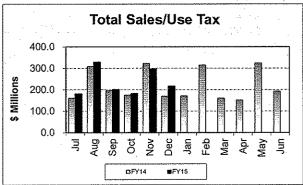
Fiscal year-to-date gross receipts are 4.5 percent higher compared to December 2013, and match the estimate for Fiscal Year 2015 of 4.5 percent.



## Personal Income Tax

Personal income tax receipts totaled \$341.1 million during December 2014. This is \$49.0 million or 16.8 percent more than the receipts of December 2013. Withholding tax receipts increased \$31.0 million or 21.1 percent compared to last year. Due to the location of the Thanksgiving holiday in relation to the end of November this year, the deposit of approximately \$16.0 million in withholding was delayed from November and instead deposited December 1 this year. Estimated payments increased \$16.3 million. Final return payments increased \$1.7 million. Fiscal year-to-date, personal income tax receipts totaled \$1,826.0 million, an increase of 5.4 percent. The current estimate for personal income tax for Fiscal Year 2015 is for an increase of 5.7 percent.



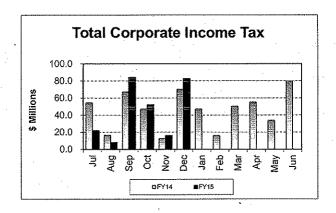


## Sales/Use Tax

December sales/use tax receipts totaled \$216.8 million, which represents an increase of \$46.7 million or 27.5 percent over December 2013. Due to the location of the Thanksgiving holiday in relation to the end of November this year, the deposit of approximately \$25.6 million in sales tax revenue was delayed from November and instead deposited December 1 this year. Fiscal year-to-date, sales/use tax receipts totaled \$1,406.8 million, an increase of 5.8 percent. The current estimate for sales/use tax for Fiscal Year 2015 is for an increase of 4.4 percent.

# Corporate Income Tax

Corporate income tax receipts during December totaled \$82.5 million, which is \$12.3 million or 17.5 percent more than in December 2013. Fiscal year-to-date corporate income tax receipts totaled \$264.5 million, a decrease of 1.1 percent. The REC's estimate for corporate income tax for Fiscal Year 2015 is for an increase of 3.8 percent.



### Refunds

For the month of December, the Department of Revenue issued \$68.5 million in refunds on a cash basis. This compares to \$60.6 million issued December 2013. For the fiscal year-to-date, total refunds issued on a cash basis were \$214.1 million. This compares to \$222.8 million issued at this time last year.
