Executive Summary

The community college tuition and fees report is prepared each year. The report includes trends among the fifteen community colleges as well as comparisons to the lowa regents institutions and national comparisons.

The following report provides tuition and fee costs and related information. Some findings include the following:

- The average annual full-time lowa Community College tuition increased \$1,437 or 81.56% over the ten-year period, from fiscal year 1999 to fiscal year 2008.
- The average annual full-time Iowa Community College tuition for academic year 2007-2008 increased \$146 (4.78%) to \$3,199 from the previous year.
- The difference in annual tuition cost among Iowa Community Colleges increased from \$405.00 in 1999 to \$454.00 in 2008.
- Over the past nine years, the average per credit hour fee rate has increased \$132.48.
- In fiscal year 2008, the average total fees charged a full-time student (15 credit hours) is \$438.56.
- The average tuition and fees per credit hour for fiscal year 2008 totaled \$116.37.
- In 1980, tuition and fees generated 24.39% of the total operating funds of lowa Community Colleges. In fiscal year 2006, 48.19% of the total operating funds of lowa Community Colleges was generated through tuition and fees.
- The Chronicle of Higher Education Almanac Issue 2005-2006 cites Iowa Community College average tuition at 55.71% above the national average in fiscal year 2005.
- Iowa ranks 2nd highest in tuition when compared to the surrounding states of South Dakota, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois, Missouri, Nebraska, and Kansas.
- The average community college credit hour tuition rate in fiscal year 2008 is \$106.62. The
 increase in the credit hour tuition ranges from 0.00% to 9.95%; the state average rate of
 increase in community college semester tuition is 4.77% over the previous year.
- Fees can be a substantial part of the cost at a community college. The total cost of fees
 range from community colleges that do not charge fees separately to a high fee charge of
 \$705.00 annually. Average fees charged equaled \$438.56 or 12.56% of the average tuition
 and fees charged.

Table 1 demonstrates how the average annual tuition for lowa Community Colleges continues to become more uniform across the state. Iowa code limits the total tuition for lowa residents attending community colleges so as not to exceed the lowest tuition rate per semester charged by a regent institution for a full-time resident student.


- The total increase in annual full-time average tuition over the past ten years from fiscal year 1999 to fiscal year 2008 is \$1,437 or 81.56%.
- Since 1999, the difference from the highest annual tuition to lowest annual tuition has increased from \$405 in fiscal year 1999, to \$454 in fiscal year 2008.
- Over this period of time, the highest annual tuition increased \$1,470 or 74.24% while the lowest annual tuition increased \$1,421 or 90.22%.

Table 2 reflects the same trend toward a more uniform tuition rate per credit hour.

- Over the past ten years, the average per credit hour tuition rate has increased \$47.90 or 81.57%.
- The difference between the highest per credit hour rate and lowest per credit hour rate decreased from \$13.50 in fiscal year 1999 to \$15.15 in fiscal year 2008.
- In fiscal year 2008, the average per credit hour tuition is \$106.62.

Figure 2: Fall Resident Tuition Per Credit Hour (Dollars)




Table 3 reflects the fees charged at each community college. Some colleges do not charge a separate fee in addition to their tuition charge. The low fee charged does not consider those colleges who do not charge separate fees. The purpose of fees charged varies from college to college. These fees are only basic fees charged and do not include any program specific fees that may be charged. See the appendix for a listing of fees charged by college.

- Over the past nine years, the average full-time* fee rate has increased \$132.48.
- In fiscal year 2008, the average total fees charged a full-time* student is \$438.56.



Figure 3: Annual* Iowa Community College Full-Time** Fees (Dollars)





Figure 4 shows the per credit hour tuition and fees charged by the individual 15 lowa Community Colleges. See Page 15 for a listing of tuition and fees charged by college.

- The average tuition and fees charged per credit hour totaled \$116.37 for fiscal year 2008.
- The difference between the highest per credit hour rate and lowest per credit hour rate for tuition and fees is \$33.50 per credit hour for fiscal year 2008.
- Tuition and Fees per credit hour increased \$5.41 (4.88%) from fiscal year 2007 to fiscal year 2008.

Tables 4 and 5 reflect the major sources of revenue for the system of lowa Community Colleges. Fiscal Year 2006 reversed the recent trend and the percentage of lowa Community College's general operating funds generated through tuition and fees decreased and the percentage derived from state general aid increased. Other sources of revenue have remained fairly consistent.

The information will differ from the previous section as the *Chronicle* data is based on information supplied to the U.S. Department of Education and includes student fees. Iowa Department of Education tables are based on information provided and verified by Iowa Community Colleges to the Division of Community Colleges and Workforce Preparation.

- From fiscal year 1999 to fiscal year 2005, Iowa Community College average tuition increased 45.62% while the national average increased 39.08%.
- Of the surrounding states, lowa ranks 2 out of 8 in average tuition cost.
- lowa Community College average tuition of \$2,876 in fiscal year 2005 is \$1,029 or 55.71% above the national average of \$1,847.





The Iowa Regent institutions increased tuition 5.22% in fiscal year 2008. See Table 10 on Page 11 for previous year(s) information.


- lowa Community Colleges increased tuition 4.78%. See Table 10 on Page 11 for previous year(s) information.
- In 2007-2008, the annual Regent institutions base tuition for full-time resident undergraduates at the three universities equaled \$5,360.
- Three (3) Iowa Community Colleges have tuition caps. Iowa Community College caps range from 19-26 credits per semester. (Students are not charged the per credit hour costs for taking courses above the cap)




