## Did You Know . . .?

## How long do I have to claim my prize?

The claim period varies by game. Instant tickets are valid for 90 days after the announced end of the game. Pick 3, Pick 4 and $\$ 100,000$ Cash Game tickets are valid for 90 days from the date of the drawing. Powerball and Hot Lotto tickets are valid for 365 days from the date of the drawing.

## Is It A Debit Card or a Credit Card?

There's a big difference! Iowa law says you cannot accept a credit card for any lottery purchase, but you can accept a debit card. What's the difference? Many banks offer their customers debit cards that can be used to withdraw money from a checking or savings account. Plus, some cards are combination credit and debit cards. Lottery players can use debit cards to purchase lottery games, but credit cards may not be used. Avoid inconveniencing your customers by checking carefully any card presented to you.

## Sweet Slots (pull-tab)

## Cost: 50 cents

Top Prize: \$50
Odds: 1 in 6.51
Begin Ordering: Dec. 13
Play by peeling apart the five tabs located on the back of the ticket. Three symbols are printed under each tab. Check all five tab areas. If three consecutive symbols printed vertically or diagonally under any of the tabs match identically any of the winning combinations shown on the ticket front, the player wins the corresponding prize. The arrow connecting the symbols indicates you are a winner.
