In 1981, the U.S. Congress passed a resolution establishing National Women's History Week. The week was chosen to coincide with International Women's Day, March 8. In 1987, Congress expanded the week to a month. Every year since, Congress and the lowa General Assembly have passed a resolution for Women's History Month, and the U.S. president and lowa's Governor have issued a proclamation.

## 1,564,081

The number of females in lowa in 2014. That exceeds the number of men $(1,543,045)$. Males outnumber females in most of the five-year-age groups through the 45-49 age group. Starting with the 50-54 age group, women outnumber men. At ages 85 and over there are twice as many women as men.

## 1,729,081

The projected female population of lowa in 2050 according to Woods \& Poole Economics, Inc. Women will constitute 49.8 percent of the states's total population.

## Families and Children

## 19.9\%

The percent of families with children under 18 in 2014 living in single-parent households with their mother compared to 9.6 percent living with their father. This compares to 70.4 percent living with both parents.

## 110,374

The number of lowa families with a female householder, no husband present in 2014. In 1970 there were 52,025 families with a female head of household. This is a $112.2 \%$ increase during that time.

## 679,478

Number of married women in 2014 (including those who are separated or have an absent spouse).

## 51.5\%

Percent of unmarried lowans 15 years and older who are women in 2014. There are 590,967 unmarried (widowed, divorced or never married) women.

## 82,345

The number of female-owned businesses in 2012.

## 3.6\%

The unemployment rate for women age 20 to 64 in lowa in 2014. The unemployment rate for men was $4.4 \%$.

## Earnings <br> \$36,522

The median earnings in 2014 inflation-adjusted dollars for fulltime, year-round women workers in lowa. Men in lowa had median earnings of $\$ 47,202$.

## Occupations 157,480

The number of lowa women in office and administrative support occupations in 2014. Women represent a wide variety of occupations in lowa. For instance, there are about 67,584 women in healthcare practitioner and technical occupations, 55,067 in management occupations and 77,379 in education, training and library occupations.

## 39.4\%

The percent of all women in lowa in the Management, business, science, and arts occupations in 2014.

## Voting and Representation

## $53.0 \%$

The percentage of registered women in Iowa who reported voting in the 2014 general election. The number of registered males who voted in the same election was $53.2 \%$.

## 28.6\%

In 2015 women comprise $28.6 \%$ of statewide elected executive office holders, $22.7 \%$ of the state legislature, and $16.7 \%$ of Iowa's congressional delegation after electing its first woman to the U.S. Congress in 2014.

## Industry <br> 296,260

The number of lowa women in the Education, Health, and Social services industry in 2014. More women, 38.9\% of lowa's total female labor force, work in this one industry group than in any other.

## 12.1\%

The percent of women who work in the Retail Trade estate industry in 2014, the second highest industry for the female labor force. Approximately 9.1 percent work in the finance and insurance industry; 8.7 percent work in manufacturing; 8.6 percent in the arts, entertainment and recreation industry; and 7.3 percent work in the professional, scientific, and management services.

Live births per 1,000 population in 2014.

## 356.6

The rate of lowa births to unmarried women in 2014. (per 1,000 births).

## 53.2

The birth rate for women age 15-19 in lowa per 1,000 women in 2014.

## 9.5

The 2014 death rate for women in lowa per 1,000 population. For men in lowa the death rate was 9.3 over the same time period.
