Workshop: Ensuring Resident Rights in Long-Term Care

Iowa Valley Continuing Education 3702 S Center St., Room 808 Marshalltown, IA 50158 (9 a.m. - 4 p.m.)

This all-day workshop sponsored by Iowa Valley Continuing Education will address sexuality and intimacy among long-term care residents and focus on managing safe sexual expression, capacity to consent, guidance on policy development and residents' rights and obstacles to honoring those rights, as well as the role and function of the Office of the State Long-Term Care Ombudsman. Issues involving dementia and legal decision-makers (e.g., POA, guardianship, conservatorship and court orders) will also be discussed. This workshop is designed for nurses, social workers, therapists, nursing facility administrators, department heads in long-term care, case managers, resident advocates and long-term care providers. Upon successful completion, 0.69 CEUs for nurses and certificates of completion for other health care professionals will be provided.
