

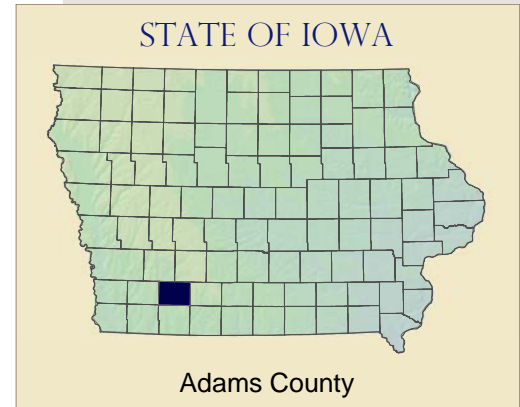

## 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

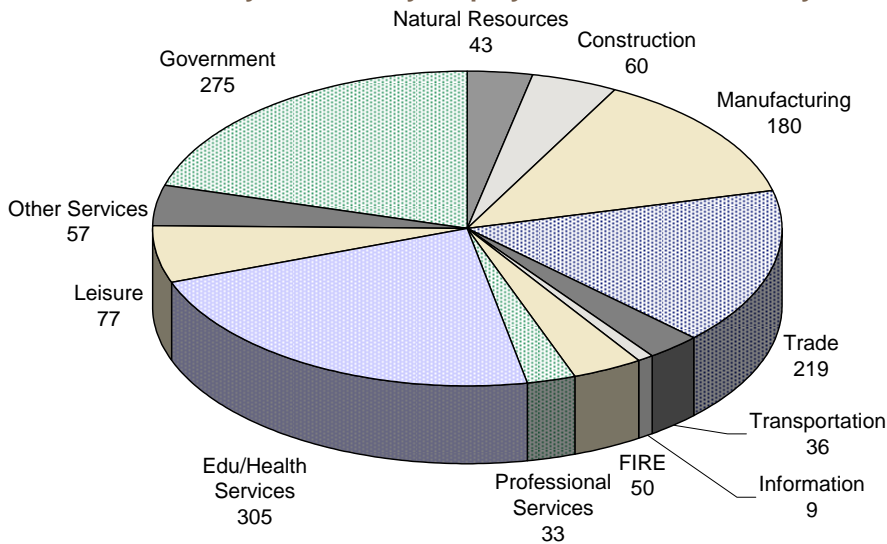
### Executive Summary

As of 2003, Adams County's largest sector was Education and Health Services, representing 22.68 percent (305) of the county's total covered employment of 1,345. Most of the employment in this sector was in the Nursing Care Facilities industry. The county's total employment increased by 1.43 percent since 2002 and the average annual wage increased by 4.15 percent to \$23,958 for all industries.

Adams County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$461 for 2003. This was an increase of 4.30 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a sector was in Manufacturing, averaging \$716 with gross total wages of \$6.7 million. Between 2002 and 2003, the Professional & Business Services sector had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 19.63 percent (\$96).

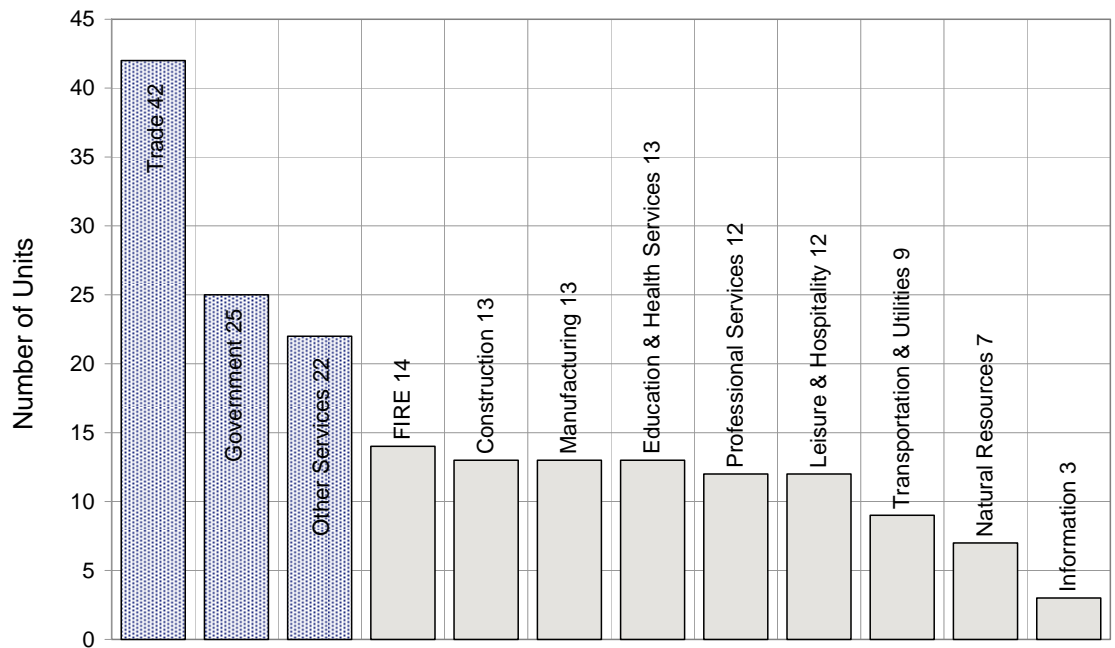

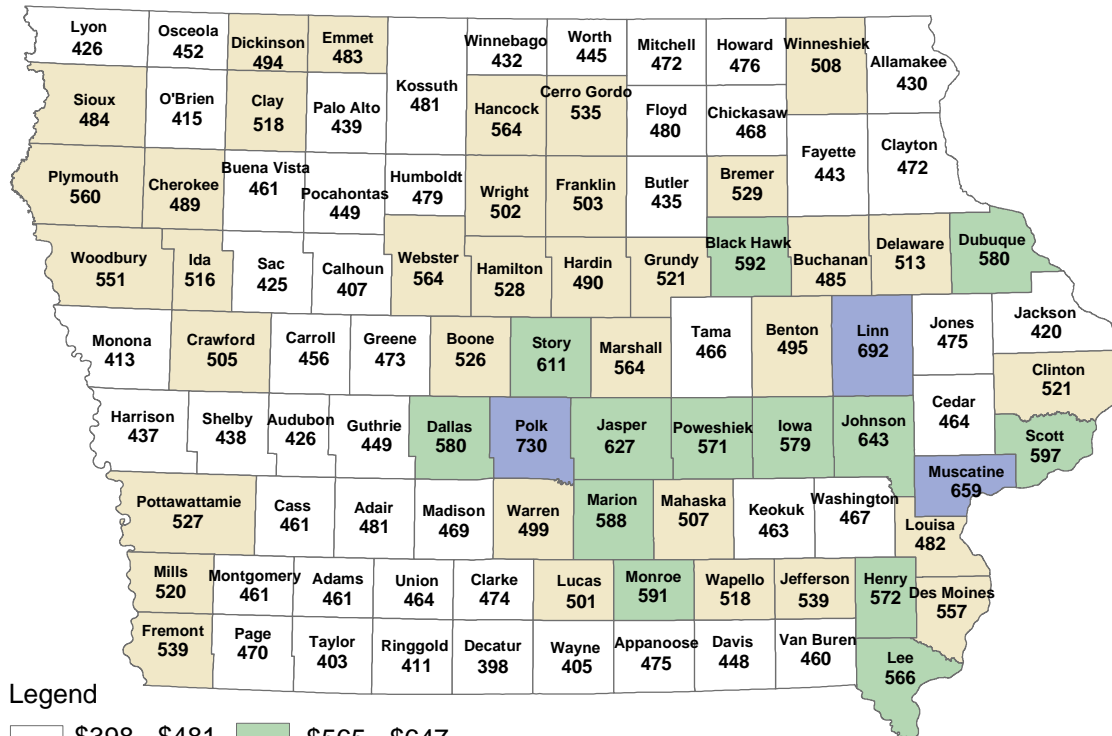

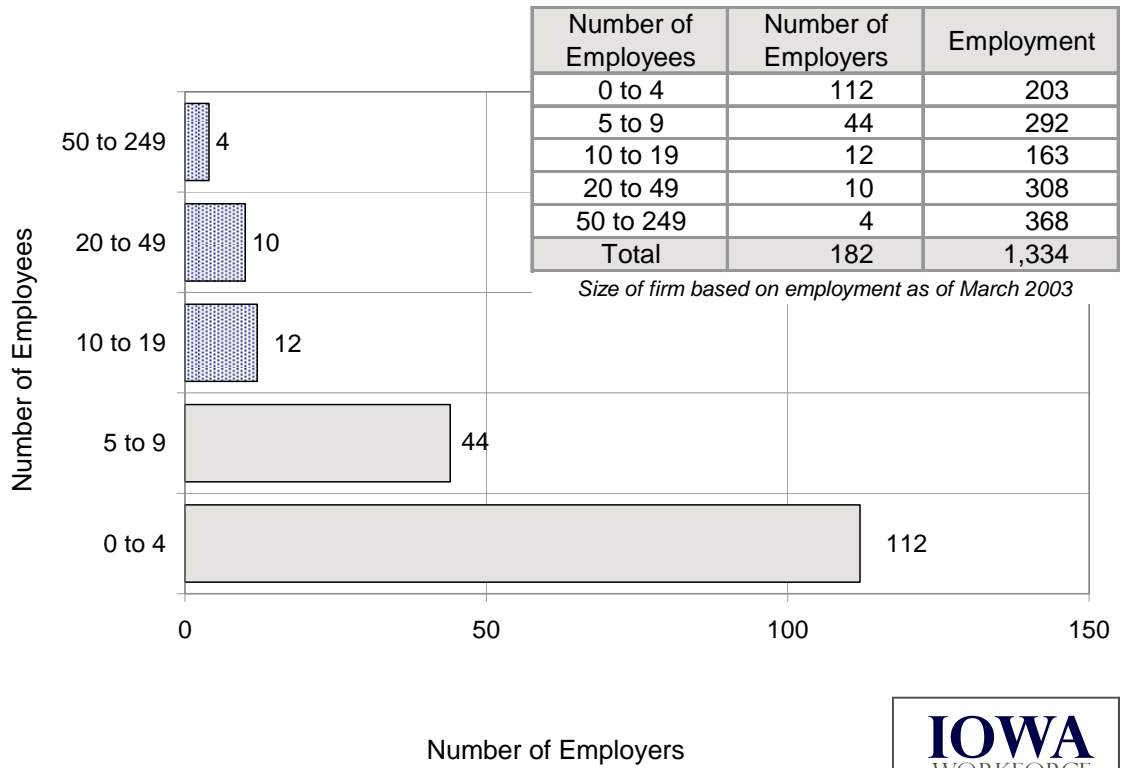
