## 2004 ANNUAL COUNTY PROFILE

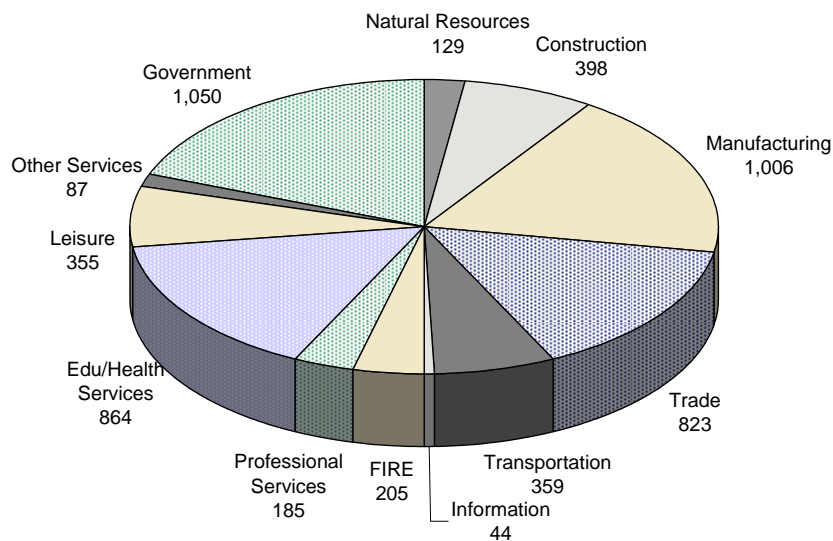
### Executive Summary

As of 2003, Cherokee County's largest private industry was Manufacturing, representing 18.28 percent (1,006) of the county's total covered employment of 5,504. Although the county's total employment decreased by 1.75 percent since 2002, the average annual wage increased by 2.99 percent to \$25,445 for all industries. Government employment consists mainly of nursing care facilities.

Cherokee County's average weekly wage for all industries was \$489 for 2003. This was an increase of 2.95 percent since 2002. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector was in Construction, averaging \$649 with gross total wages of \$13.4 million. Between 2002 and 2003, the Information sector had the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 24.92 percent (\$75).

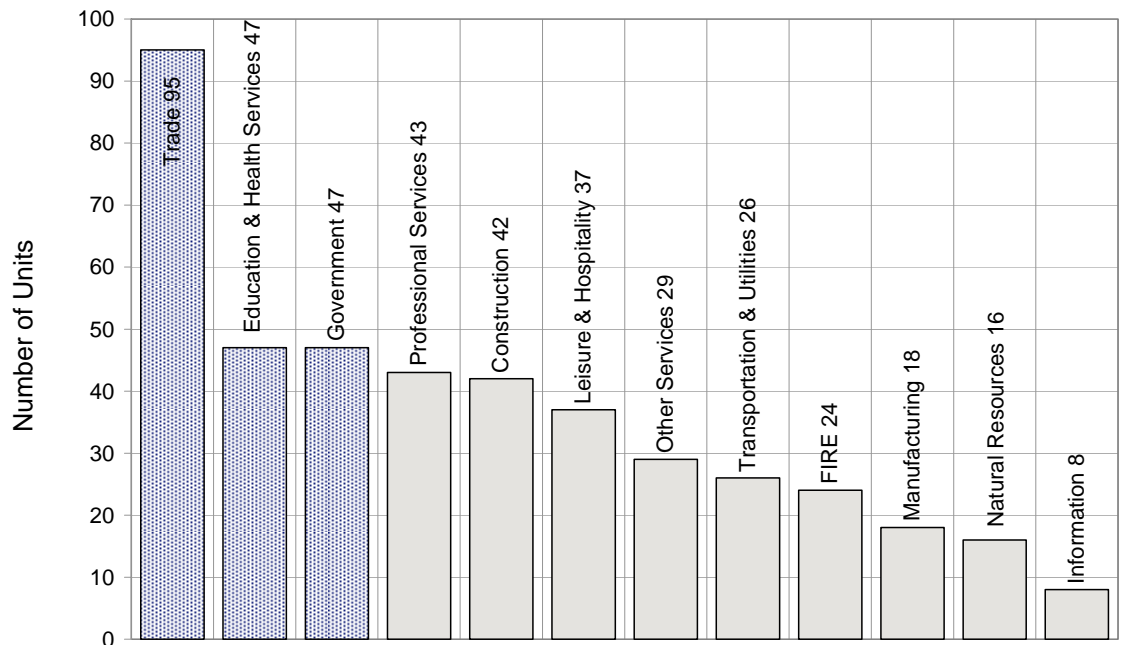

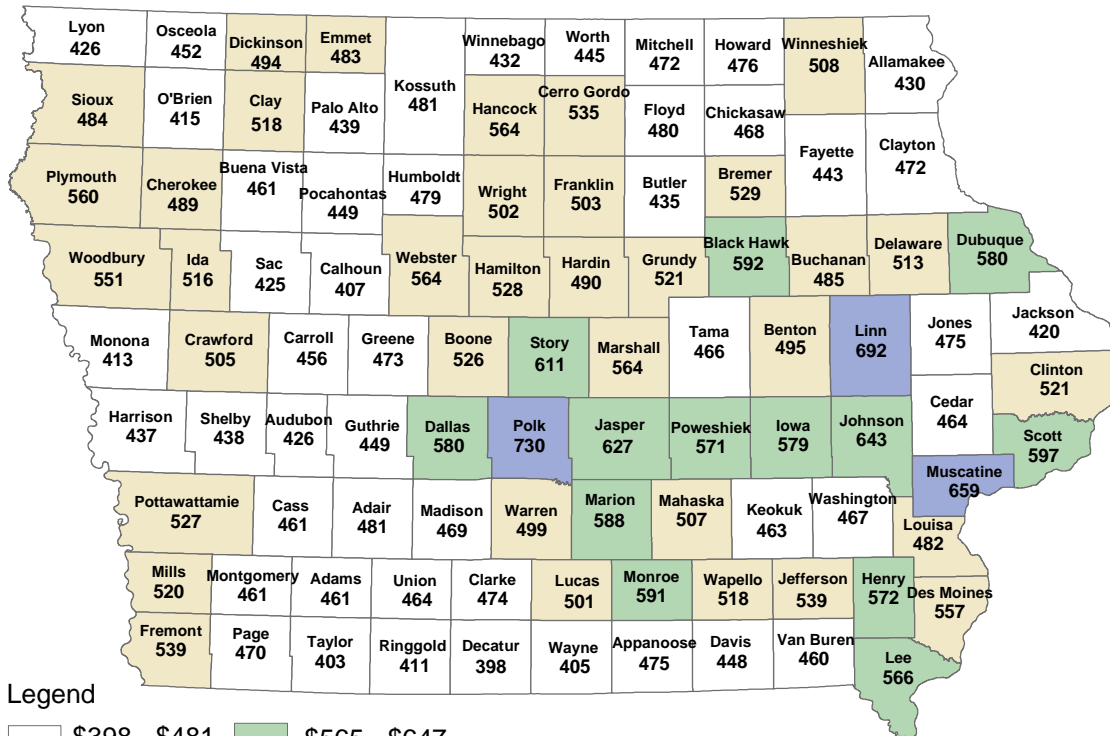

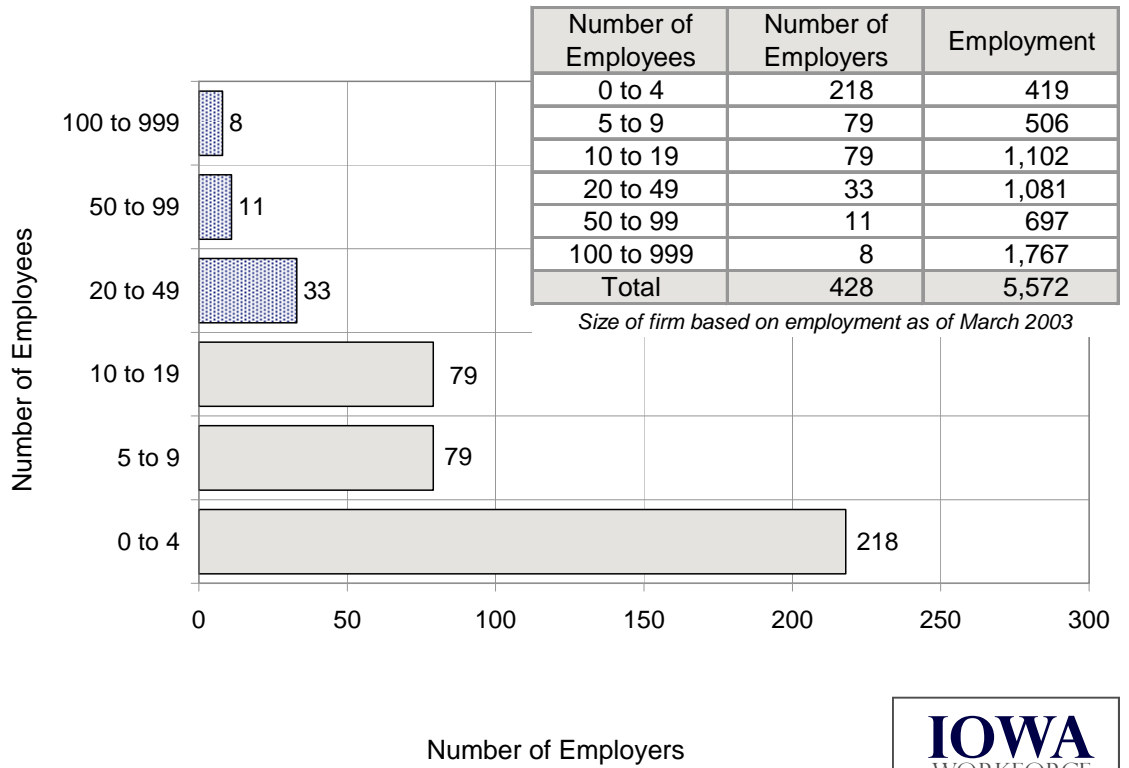
